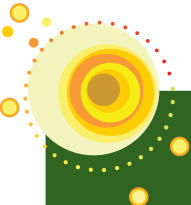

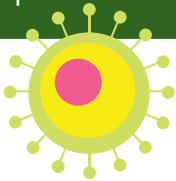


Introducing TERI Press
