Key Factors of Digital/Crypto Wallets

DECENTRALIZED

A **DECENTRALIZED** wallet resists the control of central authority. That means that if you're holding an asset backed currency or other cryptocurrency in a private wallet it **cannot be taken** or seized by an outside authority, or even the developers of those currencies themselves. You can store your funds knowing that they are safe as long as you protect your private keys.

NON-CUSTODIAL

A **NON-CUSTODIAL** wallet allows you to hold, send, and receive digital currencies and crypto assets by allowing you to directly interact with the blockchain (distributed ledger) without any middlemen involved. With a non-custodial wallet you are in full control over your funds.

DIGITAL/CRYPTO WALLETS

Digital/Crypto Wallets

Hot Wallets

HOT WALLETS are basically the software wallets (mobile wallets, web wallets, and desktop wallets) that connect to the internet and generally offer somewhat lesser security than cold wallets. However, hot wallets offer better accessibility due to their connection with the internet.

Cold Wallets

COLD WALLETS are the wallets that store the digital currencies and crypto tokens in an offline mode (paper wallets and hardware wallets). They serve as vaults that you can use for everyday transactions. There are some types of cold wallets that connect to the internet even while retaining their basic working functionality.

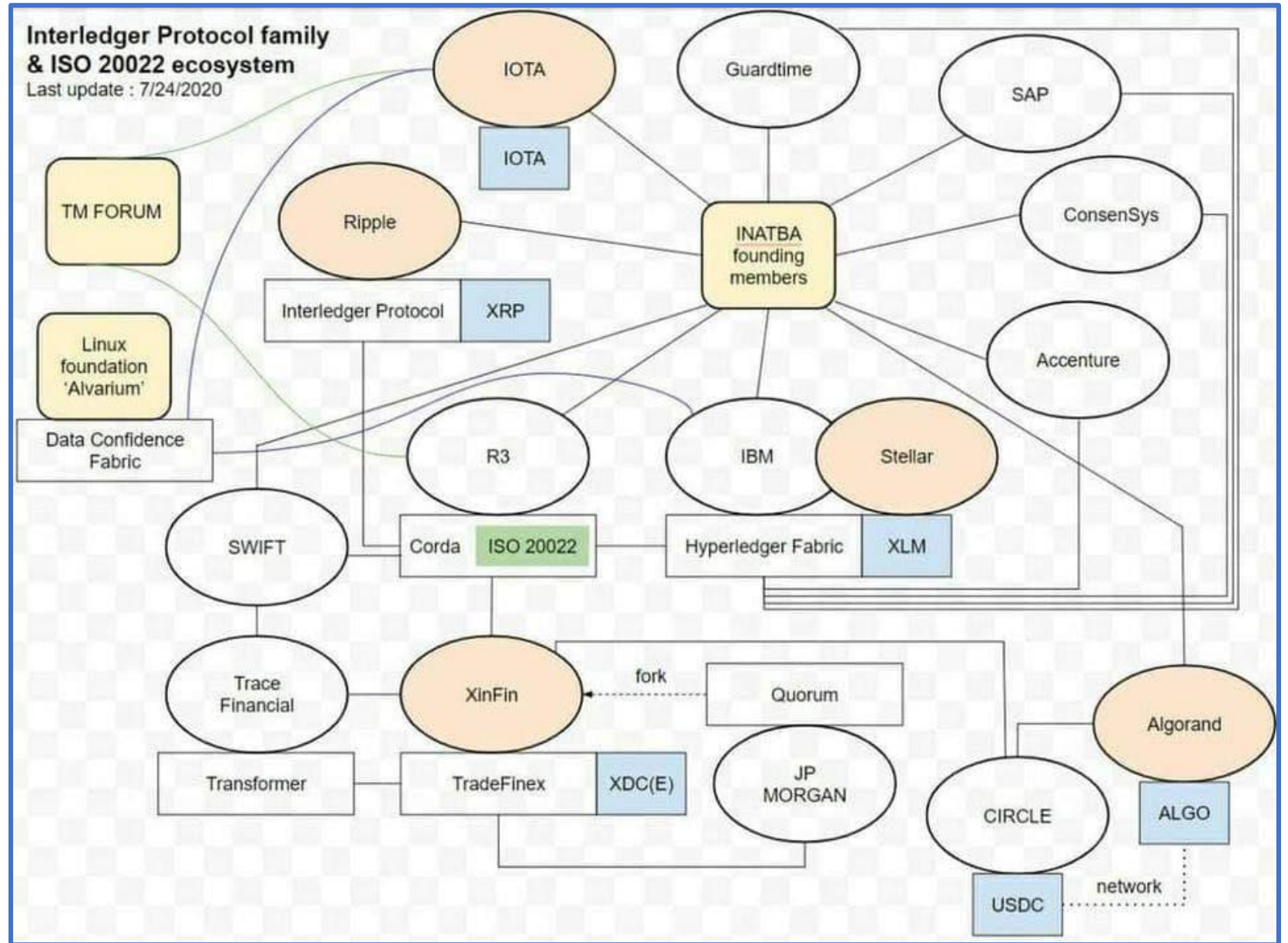

Intro to Stellar



Stellar is an open-source network for currencies and payments. Stellar makes it possible to create, send and trade digital representations of all forms of money—dollars, pesos, bitcoin, pretty much anything. It's designed so all the world's financial systems can work together on a single network.

Stellar has no owner; if anything it's owned by the public. The software runs across a decentralized, open network and handles millions of transactions each day. Like Bitcoin and Ethereum, Stellar relies on blockchain to keep the network in sync, but the end-user experience is more like cash—Stellar is much faster, cheaper, and more energy-efficient than typical blockchain-based systems.

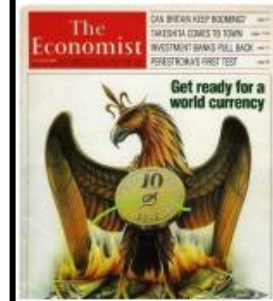

Anatomy of an asset











Each Stellar asset has two characteristics: the asset code and the issuer. When you look up or interact with an asset on Stellar, you always use both to identify it.

Many Stellar tokens represent credits that can be redeemed for something outside the network—often fiat currency, but also bonds, carbon credits, gold, etc.—and since more than one organization can issue a credit representing the same underlying asset, asset codes often overlap. More than one company offers a USD token on Stellar, for instance.

However, the combination of asset code and issuer allows each asset to be uniquely identified: each USD token is offered by, and redeemable with, one specific issuer.

PREPARATIONS

This will be explained as learned by myself through prayer, countless hours of research, and trial and error.

I reside in the State of Texas, USA, therefore, there may be some differences, or currencies that may or may not be available depending on where you live. Always research and use your own discernment.

PREPARATIONS:

- Have a Mobile (Cell) Phone, iPad, and/or Laptop or Desktop Computer, with email access. I highly recommend using a Laptop or Desktop Computer to set up your wallet(s) if available. You can later use the Mobile App, if available, to access your wallet.
- Have your form of legal identification ready for upload, i.e. Drivers License, Passport, etc.
- Have your Debit card ready for possible selfie picture with your Debit card to be uploaded for further identification.
- It is recommended to use a Debit card instead of a Credit card, as you may be charged a Cash Advance Fee with using a Credit card, which can be expensive.
- Depending on your location, a Virtual Private Network (VPN) may be needed on your device for the transaction(s) to go through.
- Have a pen and paper to write down your keys, password, etc. to your digital wallet and keep them in a safe place.

COMMENTS AND NOTES TO KEEP IN MIND

- Write down and keep your keys/codes to your wallet in an off-line safe and secure place. It is recommended to have the keys/codes kept in more than one safe place.
- YOU and ONLY YOU are responsible for your keys/codes. Whoever has your keys/codes has access to your wallet.
- These are Decentralized Wallets...there is no “I forgot my password”, so write it down and keep it in a safe place.
- If using a Wallet that is based in another Country than where you live, the Wallets’ banking partner may be located in another Country as well. Therefore, keep in mind while using your Debit card, you may incur a “cross border fee” along with the Debit transaction amount from your bank account. This fee could be 1%, 2% or more of the total. Inquire with your bank.
- If the Wallets’ banking partner is located in another Country, you may need to notify your bank ahead of time to allow the overseas charge to go through on your Debit card.
- Some banks do not allow any “cross border” transactions with their Debit cards, so keep this in mind. If the bank suggests they will provide a Visa or other prepaid Debit card, know this WILL NOT work. The card you use MUST be tied to you and your identification.

BUYING/EXCHANGING DIGITAL CURRENCIES

I have personal experience with Atomic Wallet, Guarda Wallet, Ledger Nano X, Ledger Live, Trezor, StellarPort, and StellarTerm so I will use some of these wallets with explanations as I am familiar with them. The other wallets listed in this presentation should work similarly.

ATOMIC WALLET (ALGO, XRP, XLM)

Download and install Atomic Wallet (<https://atomicwallet.io>). Write down and keep your keys and password in a safe off-line place.

Note - Depending on where you are located you may not be able to be able to “BUY” XRP direct, but you can “BUY” XLM then “EXCHANGE” for XRP. The same may apply to ALGO. Use trial an error, see what currencies show available for “BUY” and/or “EXCHANGE”.

ATOMIC WALLET – “BUYING” XLM

We will proceed with this example as if you are unable to “BUY” XRP direct, so you will “BUY” XLM then “EXCHANGE” some XLM for the XRP.

Select “BUY” from the menu enter the amount for your purchase and select XLM from the search menu of coins.

Proceed to enter your debit card information, address, phone, email, date of birth, etc. on the next two screens. If this is your first time purchasing, you will be prompted to upload the front and back of your Driver’s License or Passport. You may also be required to upload a selfie with your debit card. Just follow instructions. If all is approved, you will be prompted to the next screen signifying such. Check your email and you will have received 2 emails “Payment Approved” and “Payment Submitted”. There is information regarding your purchase in these emails. Once your transaction has been listed you will receive a third email “Your blockchain transaction ID”. Your XLM should show in your wallet relatively quickly, however for the first time purchase it may take a bit longer due to identification verification. Once your XLM is in your wallet within the next 24 hours you will receive a 4th email “Did you receive your cryptocurrency?”, select “YES” on this email and you will be forwarded to a website completing your transaction.

You can also go directly to the XLM Block (Ledger) to see your Atomic Wallet XLM account transactions. Go to your Atomic Wallet, select the currency XLM and click RECEIVE to obtain your Atomic Wallet’s XLM Public Address. Select COPY then go to <https://stellar.expert/explorer/public/> and PASTE the copied XLM Public Address in the search bar (upper right-hand corner of page). This is your LIVE Block (Ledger) for your Atomic Wallet XLM address. Sometimes the coins will show in the Block (Ledger) before they show in your wallet.

Your XLM Purchase transaction is complete. Congratulations you now own XLM (Silver backed digital currency)!

BUYING/EXCHANGING DIGITAL CURRENCIES

ATOMIC WALLET – “BUYING” XRP

Check to see if **XRP** displays from the search menu of coins when in the “**BUY**” menu. If you are able to “**BUY**” **XRP** direct, then proceed with the transaction as explained in the prior page, you will just be purchasing **XRP** instead of **XLM**.

ATOMIC WALLET – “EXCHANGING” XLM FOR XRP

Select “**EXCHANGE**” from the menu enter the number of **XLM** you wish to “**EXCHANGE**” on the left and it will automatically compute with current pricing for the number of **XRP** you will be RECEIVING for this “**EXCHANGE**”. Be sure to select these appropriate coins from the drop-down menu. Do not “**EXCHANGE**” all your **XLM**, stay diversified in your digital currencies and keep some of your **XLM**. The “**EXCHANGE**” should not take too long.

Congratulations you now own **XRP** (Gold backed digital currency)!

You can also go directly to the **XRP** Block (Ledger) to see your Atomic Wallet **XRP** account transactions. Go to your Atomic Wallet, select the currency **XRP** and click RECEIVE to obtain your Atomic Wallet’s **XRP** Public Address. Select COPY then go to <https://xrpscan.com> and PASTE the copied **XRP** Public Address in the search bar (upper right-hand corner of page). This is your LIVE Block (Ledger) for your Atomic Wallet **XRP** address. Sometimes the coins will show in the Block (Ledger) before they show in your wallet.

ATOMIC WALLET – “BUYING” ALGO

Check to see if **ALGO** displays from the search menu of coins when in the “**BUY**” menu. If you are able to “**BUY**” **ALGO** direct, then proceed with the transaction as explained in the prior page, you will just be purchasing **ALGO** instead of **XLM**.

If you are unable to “**BUY**” **ALGO** direct, then proceed with the “**EXCHANGE**” instructions above, and “**EXCHANGE**” some **XLM** for **ALGO**. Be sure to select the appropriate coins from the drop-down menu. NOTE – randomly over the course of the past year **ALGO** has not been available for “**BUY**” or “**EXCHANGE**”, continue to check back on a later date to see when **ALGO** becomes available again. **ALGO** will automatically “**STAKE**” and you will immediately begin earning 7.2% on your **ALGO** currency. AWESOME!!

Congratulations you now own **ALGO** (Palladium backed digital currency)!

BUYING/EXCHANGING DIGITAL CURRENCIES

You can also go directly to the **ALGO** Block (Ledger) to see your Atomic Wallet **ALGO** account transactions. Go to your Atomic Wallet, select the currency **ALGO** and click RECEIVE to obtain your Atomic Wallet's **ALGO** Public Address. Select COPY then go to <https://algoexplorer.io> and PASTE the copied **ALGO** Public Address in the search bar (upper right-hand corner of page). This is your LIVE Block (Ledger) for your Atomic Wallet **ALGO** address. Sometimes the coins will show in the Block (Ledger) before they show in your wallet.

ATOMIC WALLET – NOTES

Simplex is the banking partner with Atomic Wallet, so “**BUY**” transaction emails will come from Simplex. Four (4) emails per “**BUY**” transaction.

If there is an error or something does not go right during your transaction and your bank account reflects the funds being drafted or pending draft, and your purchased currency does not show in your wallet...DO NOT PANIC. Give it some time to see if the currency shows in your wallet, refer back to the Simplex emails where you have the payment ID. If the currency still does not arrive in your wallet, you can go through “SUPPORT” on the Atomic Wallet menu, or you can go through Simplex with your “Payment Submitted” email received and “Start a live chat...”, or “Submit a support ticket...”. Always use your “Payment ID” and follow the instructions. If the currency is not delivered your funds WILL be returned. The Block (Ledger) ALWAYS balances, so please have no fear. Things can happen with any wallet, internet outage, internet glitch, etc.

GUARDA WALLET (ALGO, XRP, XLM, XDC)

Download and install Guarda Wallet (<https://guarda.com>). Guarda Wallet does not have a multi-word phrase as its keys to the wallet. Guarda utilizes an encrypted Backup File. Write down your password in a safe off-line place. Go to “Settings” and select “Download Backup”, keep this backup file in a safe off-line place. Make a habit of downloading a backup after you have purchased currencies on the Guarda Wallet.

Note - Depending on where you are located you may not be able to be able to “**BUY**” **XRP** direct, but you can “**BUY**” **XLM** then “**EXCHANGE**” for **XRP**. The same may apply to **ALGO**. Use trial an error, see what currencies show available for “**BUY**” and/or “**EXCHANGE**”.

BUYING/EXCHANGING DIGITAL CURRENCIES

GUARDA WALLET – “BUYING” XDC

We will proceed with this example to “**BUY**” **XDC**, since we have already shown examples of the other asset backed digital currencies.

Select “**BUY**” from the menu enter the amount for your purchase and select **XDC** from the search menu of coins.

Proceed to enter your debit card information, address, phone, email, date of birth, etc. on the following screens. If this is your first time purchasing, you will be prompted to upload the front and back of your Driver’s License or Passport. You may also be required to upload a selfie with your debit card. Just follow instructions. If all is approved, you will be prompted to the next screen signifying such. Check your email and you will have received 2 emails “Payment Approved” and “Payment Submitted”. There is information regarding your purchase in these emails. Once your transaction has been listed you will receive a third email “Your blockchain transaction ID”. Your **XDC** should show in your wallet relatively quickly, however for the first time purchase it may take a bit longer due to identification verification. Once your **XDC** is in your wallet within the next 24 hours you will receive a 4th email “Did you receive your cryptocurrency?”, select “YES” on this email and you will be forwarded to a website completing your transaction.

You can also go directly to the **XDC** Block (Ledger) to see your Guarda Wallet **XDC** account transactions. Go to your Guarda Wallet, select the currency **XDC** and click RECEIVE to obtain your Guarda Wallet’s **XDC** Public Address. Select COPY then go to <https://explorer.xinfin.netwrk> and PASTE the copied **XDC** Public Address in the search bar (top left of page). This is your LIVE Block (Ledger) for your Guarda Wallet **XDC** address. Sometimes the coins will show in the Block (Ledger) before they show in your wallet.

Your **XDC** Purchase transaction is complete. Congratulations you now own **XDC** (Copper backed digital currency)!

GUARDA WALLET – NOTES

Simplex is the banking partner with Guarda Wallet, so “**BUY**” transaction emails will come from Simplex. Four (4) emails per “**BUY**” transaction.

Refer above under Atomic Wallet for any errors that may occur during the transaction, the same information applies to Guarda Wallet.

Guarda Wallet has a tendency to “time-out” while using the software. Just close out and reopen.

BUYING/EXCHANGING DIGITAL CURRENCIES

“BUYING” IOTA

As of the date of this overview I have not been able to successfully purchase **IOTA**. I have attempted many different times over the course of the past year, spent several hours troubleshooting different avenues (staying on the decentralized, non-custodial tract) and have not been successful. Last attempt I downloaded FireFly which is the wallet connection to Ledger Nano X for storing **IOTA**, but was unable to purchase **IOTA** through BitFinex, as I was blocked because **IOTA** is unavailable in my region (Texas USA). I have elected to not go through Binance or Kucoin, so I have not attempted with these routes. Please do your own research and depending on your location, you may have success.

LOBSTR WALLET (ALGO, XRP, XLM, IOTA)

Download and install Lobstr Wallet (<https://lobstr.co>). Lobstr is a Stellar based **XLM** wallet. I do not have personal experience with Lobstr, but research shows it to be a good, safe wallet. Another good site for Lobstr information is <https://qsiresources.com> select “For New Stellar Users”. There is a wealth of information on this site.

Note - Depending on where you are located you may not be able to be able to “**BUY**” **XRP** direct, but you should be able to “**BUY**” **XLM** then “**EXCHANGE**” for **XRP**. The same may apply to **ALGO**. Use trial an error, see what currencies show available for “**BUY**” and/or “**EXCHANGE**”. The same will apply to buying **IOTA** as it applies to other wallets, depending on your region.

LEDGER NANO X WALLET (ALGO, XRP, XLM, XDC, IOTA) – LEDGER LIVE

Ledger Nano X is a COLD/HARDWARE storage wallet with a desktop software connection through Ledger Live. This is the only wallet supporting ALL 5 of the asset backed digital currencies. However, learning to navigate, use, and understand how this wallet works, is not an easy task. Also, just because this wallet supports ALL 5 currencies, does not mean you will be able to “**BUY**” them, as you will encounter the same issues, i.e. not being able to “**BUY**” due to your region, etc.

If your concern is to have your currencies on a hardware wallet, then Ledger Nano X will be what you are looking for. However, I would recommend using one of the other wallets (Atomic, Guarda, Lobstr, etc.) to “**BUY**” your currencies, for simplicity purposes. Then you can transfer all currencies to your Ledger Nano X once you have spent time practicing, setting it up, and understanding how it works. It will take more time to learn to navigate using Ledger Nano X than the other wallets. This is being said from my own personal experience. Please do your own research and trial and error.

BUYING/EXCHANGING DIGITAL CURRENCIES

FURTHER NOTES

Use trial and error, if you have multiple wallets, i.e. Atomic, Guarda, Lobstr and/or other wallets, start the “**BUY**” process and see how many coins you will receive on each wallet for the same money for transactions happening concurrently. Also keep in mind the associated banking partner of a particular wallet and their fees, cross border fees, etc. You can use trial and error to learn which wallet works best for you and what wallet has the least amount of fees.

Apple iPhone recently (01-2022) has blocked the download of Atomic Wallet. Is Apple censoring? Use a desktop to download Atomic Wallet if this happens.

Do your own research and you will be guided to the wallet that is right for you.

Each asset backed digital currency also referred to as a Lumen (**ALGO, XRP, XLM, XDC, IOTA**) will have its own **Decentralized Exchange (DEX)** of Tokens on the Quantum Financial System (QFS). The Stellar Network's main Lumen (**XLM**) is the first to build its Stellar DEX Network of Tokens. The information is so vast regarding the QFS Tokens and it is understood from research the Stellar Networks (Stellar DEX) will become our new Stock Market, so-to-speak. A Stock Market By The People For The People. With any of the Stellar Wallets/Exchanges you can "EXCHANGE" XLM for these Tokens.

Download one of these wallets similarly to the explanations of obtaining and setting up a wallet in this presentation. Be sure to keep your keys/codes in a safe off-line place. Then "SEND" some of your XLM from your previously set up wallet where you own XLM to this new Stellar Wallet/Exchange and then "EXCHANGE" for the Tokens you want. Most Tokens are VERY cheap so you will be able to acquire many for a small amount of XLM.

It is a recommendation to become comfortable with buying, exchanging and using your new wallet to obtain the main Asset Backed Digital Currencies (**ALGO, XRP, XLM, XDC IOTA**), then venture into the vast world of Tokens.

It is NOT an Ethereum based ERC-20 asset and can not be bought or held at this time on Ethereum based wallets, swaps or exchanges, such as Trust wallet, Pancake, Uniswap or other ETH based wallets or exchanges. It's not listed at this time on major exchanges, such as Binance, Coinbase, etc., as of yet. However, it can be purchased with XLM or USDC traded on other exchanges and then sent to Stellar based exchanges and wallets (listed above) and then swapped/trade/exchanged for Doge-Token (DOGET) on those exchanges and then held there in those Stellar based wallets. The easiest Stellar based wallet to start with, is Lobstr Wallet, downloadable from Playstore. Then buy XLM on your other wallet or exchange, send it to your Lobstr wallet and then "Swap" for Doge Token (DOGET). Then Hod!!!!
