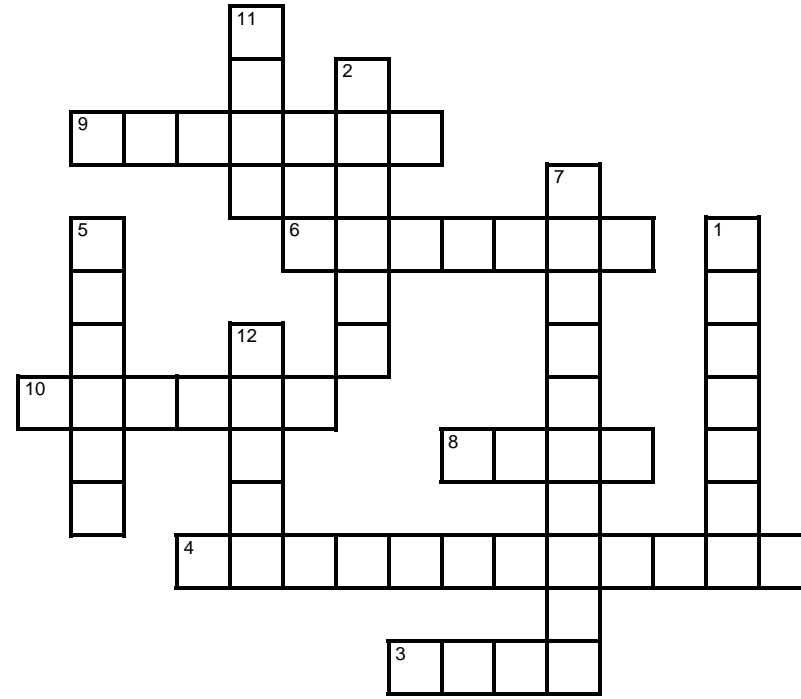

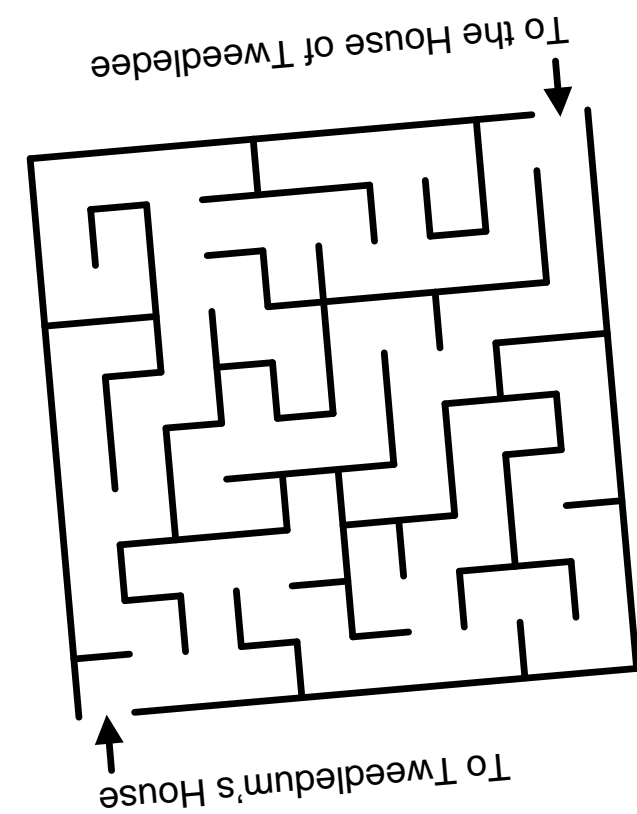


Help the Mock Turtle finish this picture.
