Landform- a natural feature of the surface of the Earth.

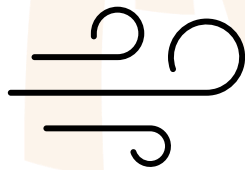
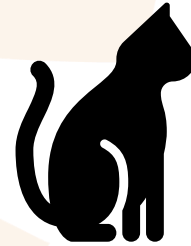
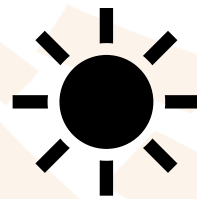
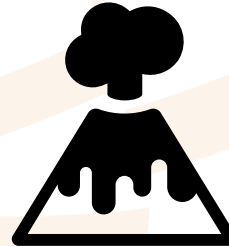
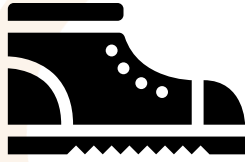
Season- a division of the year with distinguishing weather patterns and daylight hours.
