

Tanning Facility Patron Disclosure and Consent Form

DANGER, ULTRAVIOLET RADIATION. Follow instructions. Avoid overexposure. As with natural light, overexposure can cause eye and skin injury and allergic reactions. **REPEATED EXPOSURE MAY CAUSE PREMATURE AGING OF THE SKIN AND SKIN CANCER. Some harmful changes which may result from repeated overexposure to UVA/UVB radiation include cataracts, skin cancer, premature aging and possible photosensitive reactions when using perfumes, cosmetics and certain drugs, including some antibiotics and birth control pills.
