The mercury was stuck in the thermometer, so he is very cold.

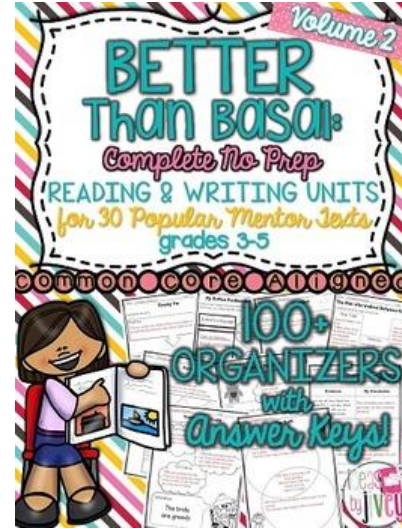
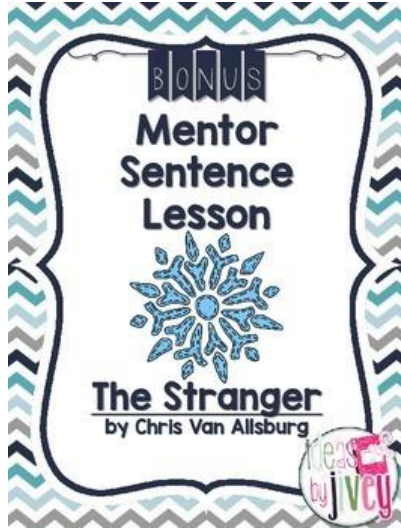
