

**LITTLEROCK YELLOW BARN SALVAGE MATERIAL  
MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT**

In accepting salvage material from the Littlerock Yellow Barn, the undersigned recipient ("Recipient") agrees to the following terms:

1) Recipient agrees to utilize all salvage materials consistent with the Recipient's application exclusively on the Heritage Barn located at:

The list of salvage material received is included as Exhibit A.

2) Recipient agrees to use all salvage materials exclusively for personal use. Resale of salvage material is prohibited. Any remaining salvage material must be returned to the Heritage Barn Salvage Program.

3) Recipient agrees to use all salvaged material in its existing condition. Milling of dimension lumber or other material for the purpose of decreasing the dimensions is not allowed without administrative approval. Exceptions may be made for sanding, planing, or otherwise finishing dimension lumber.

4) If not already listed, Recipient agrees to nominate the barn structure to the Heritage Barn Register as a condition of receiving material.

5) Recipient agrees to document the project in consultation with program administrators. A completion report must be submitted to program administrators within thirty (30) days of project completion.

6) Recipient agrees to proactively maintain all structures utilizing salvage material for a minimum of ten (10) years.

7) All work must comply with the United States Secretary of the Interior's *Standards for the Rehabilitation of Historic Properties*. Exceptions may be made on a case-by-case basis in consultation with program administrators.

8) Recipient acknowledges that material is provided 'As-is' and may include hazardous materials, nails, screws, paint and other elements typical for salvage material.

9) Recipient assumes full responsibility for payment of all federal, state and local taxes applicable to the receipt of salvage material.
