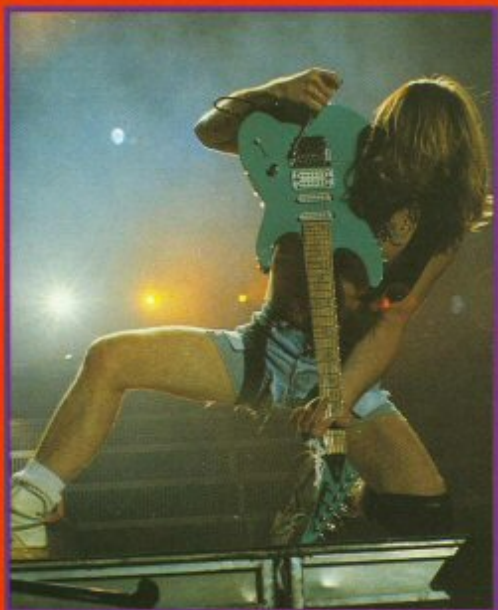

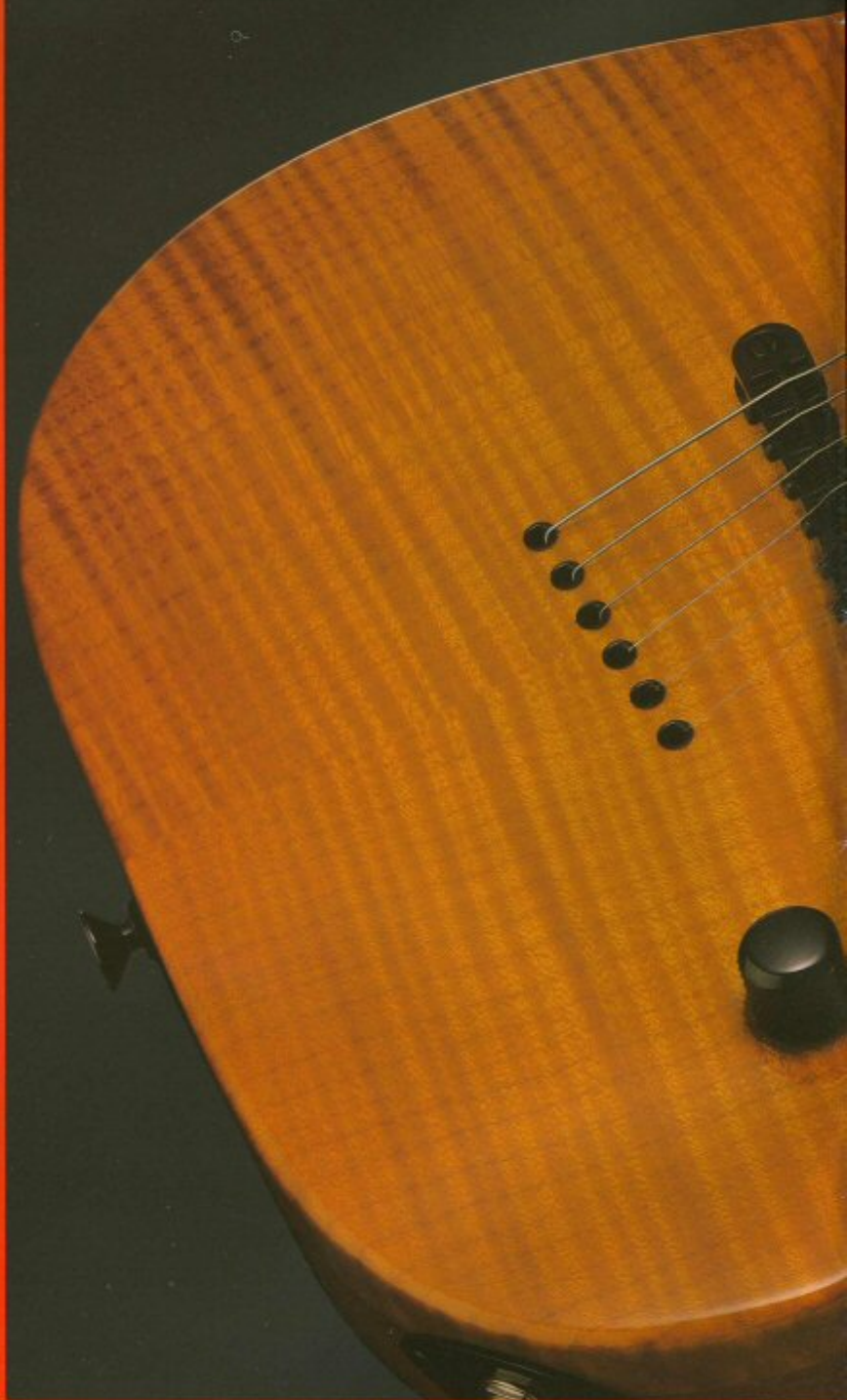

JOHN HAYES - MOTHER'S FINEST

Designed in collaboration with the late Randy Rhoads, this uniquely shaped instrument is the perfect weapon for aggressive metal. The Rhoads guitar was the first instrument to bear the Jackson name, and it still remains as the flagship for the Jackson line.

With its unique tone and solid feel, the Rhoads has become one of the few guitars to be commonly acknowledged as a contemporary classic. Rhoads guitars are used by Danny Spitz of Anthrax, Geoff Thorpe of Vicious Rumors, Stevie Blaze of Lillian Axe, and Andreas Kisser of Sepultura.

If you want to make a statement that sets you apart from other guitarists both in looks and sound, and if ripping tone and high output are what you are about, check out a Jackson Rhoads to feel and hear why so many players use them.

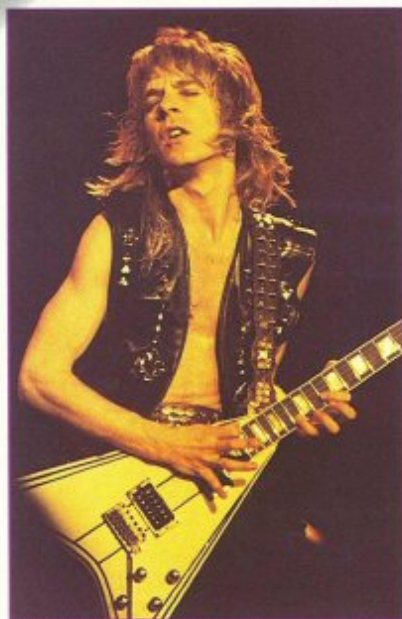

Since its development, the King V Custom has been one of the more popular body shapes the Jackson Custom Shop offers. Its popularity has grown so rapidly that we now offer two production versions. The King V Pro is built using neck through body construction with an Ebony fingerboard and a fixed non tremolo bridge with fine tuners. The King V Pro is built to the same specifications as Dave Mustaine's main guitar and is offered as one of Jackson's few signature series models.

The second model, the King V Standard, features the Jackson JT-580 Floyd Rose tremolo system and is a bolt on neck with Rosewood fingerboard. Brian Tilsie of Rob Halford's band Fight is using several King V Standard models on their current tour. Both King V models offer a very harmonically rich sound by virtue of their larger bodies and unusual shape.

Many guitarists have rediscovered that large bodied guitars like the Kelly offer a very big and unique sonic signature over their conventional shaped and sized counterparts. This voice is particularly useful for players who utilize big power chords and biting lead lines in their playing. All three Jackson Kelly guitars feature two octave fingerboards and allow for easy access to the highest frets due to the very deep lower cutaway of the body design. The Kelly Pro is a neck through body instrument with bound Ebony fingerboard, while the Kelly XL & Kelly Standard models have bolt on necks with Rosewood fingerboards.

Kelly guitars are used by Marty Friedman of Megadeth, as he says they fit his playing style perfectly. Pete Lee (Flatus Maximus) of Gwar uses Kellys and Rhoads guitars because of their aggressive sound and image. Matt Thomas of Crowbar has just picked up his first Kelly for the same reasons. If a unique look and monster tone are what you have been searching for, be sure and check out a Kelly.

The Stealth EX is built around an ultra sleek Basswood body, coupled to our extremely fast playing 17mm neck. This guitar offers light weight, comfort, speed, and so much sonic warmth and versatility you would think it would cost twice the price. The Stealth EX is available in a special model for left handed players.

The Stealth HX offers a slightly thicker body than the Stealth EX for a fatter low end response. The unusual three humbucker pickup configuration offers plenty of output and very fat harmonically rich sound possibilities. The strings are run through the body for maximum sustain, and the non tremolo tunamic bridge offers very accurate intonation and height adjustment of the strings.

Frank Aresti of Fates Warning and Michael Mostert of Bigg Mouth are both using Stealth models.

STEALTH

Guitarists have long searched for an instrument that would combine the light string tension and percussive attack of a Les Paul with the overall brighter sounds of a bolt on neck guitar. Our answer to this quest is the Jackson Fusion Series of guitars. All Fusion Series models have a slightly reduced scale length which gives these guitars their light string tension and percussive attack, and because they are bolt on neck guitars, they have that brighter overall sound.

The Fusion HH body is built from Mahogany to bring out and enhance the mid range frequencies, while the Fusion Standard and Fusion EX models both use Basswood bodies for brighter string attack. Fusion Series guitars are used by England's Dave Sharman, New Age guitarist Paul Speer, Don Carr of the Oak Ridge Boys, and Don Teschner.

This custom neck through body guitar was designed by Jackson staff member Kurt Hendrick who has built guitars for Billy Gibbons, Joe Perry, and Stevie Ray Vaughan. It features neck through body construction using Mahogany for the wings, and select grade quartersawn Maple for the center section. The strings are anchored through the body for maximum sustain and the guitar was built using Dimarzio pickups.



Custom King V guitar built using Korina wood for the construction of the body and neck, and a slab cut ebony fingerboard. Korina wood guitars have recently been built for Dave Mustaine and Danny Spitz. This exotic African hard wood offers a very unique tone with lots of midrange and a very smooth top end.



African Ribbon Mahogany was used for the back and neck construction of this very custom Kelly. Brazilian Rosewood was used for the fingerboard, and a highly figured piece of premium grade Maple was chosen for the top. A reverse headstock with gold hardware and Dimarzio pickups were used to complete this truly unique instrument.



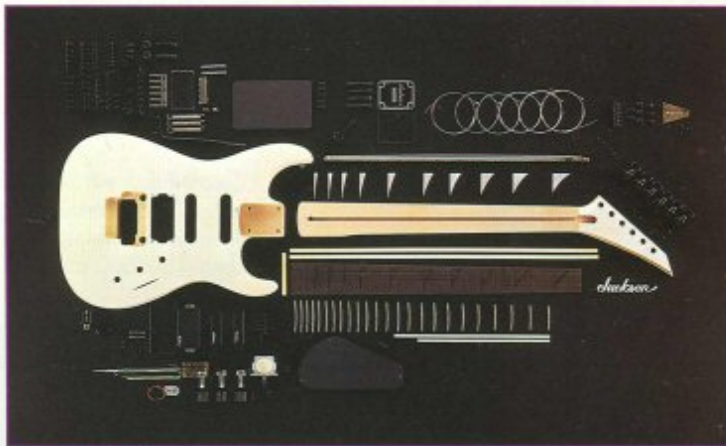

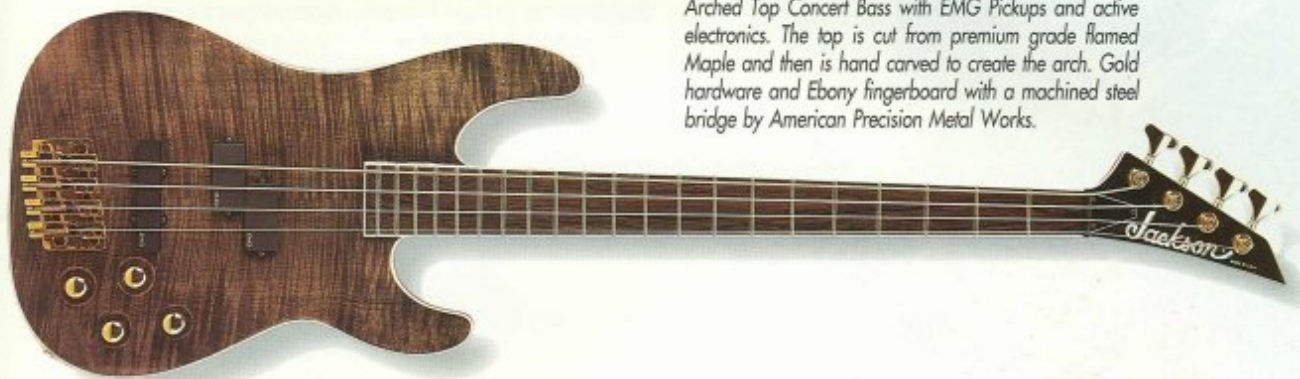

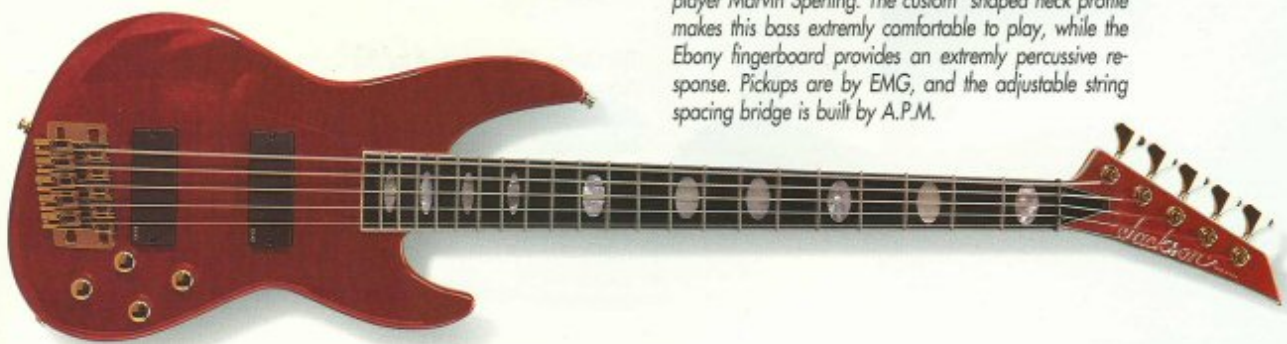

Arched Top Concert Bass with EMG Pickups and active electronics. The top is cut from premium grade flamed Maple and then is hand carved to create the arch. Gold hardware and Ebony fingerboard with a machined steel bridge by American Precision Metal Works.



Custom neck through body Futura Bass with Paduck fingerboard and flamed Maple body. Neck section is made from quartersawn Eastern Maple for rigidity and stability. EMG Model 35 pickups and A.P.M. bridge were used to complete this great sounding instrument.



Five string Futura Bass created for Los Angeles session player Marvin Sperling. The custom shaped neck profile makes this bass extremely comfortable to play, while the Ebony fingerboard provides an extremely percussive response. Pickups are by EMG, and the adjustable string spacing bridge is built by A.P.M.



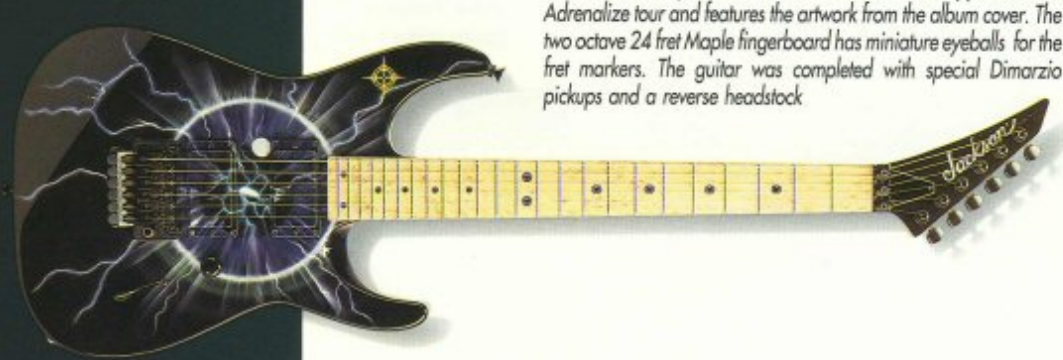
Custom Rhoads with Silver Surfer graphic including painted pickup covers. The body bevels were painted in a silver contrast color to frame the body shape and graphic. Chrome hardware and a bound Ebony fingerboard complete the package.



Special order body shape with reverse headstock gave this guitar a very unique look. Mother of Pearl Sharkfin inlays and a Monotone Chinese Dragon graphic with Seymour Duncan pickups were used to finish off this customer's order.



This Custom Shop Rhoads was ordered by a customer who wanted it to have a very pronounced midrange response. The body was made from maple and the neck was made using a Bound Ebony fingerboard to achieve the desired sound. Reverse headstock and upside down inlays were used per the owner's order.



This Custom Dinky was built for Phil Collen of Def Leppard for the Adrenalize tour and features the artwork from the album cover. The two octave 24 fret Maple fingerboard has miniature eyeballs for the fret markers. The guitar was completed with special Dimarzio pickups and a reverse headstock.



Neck through body Custom Soloist with Mahogany body and Flamed Maple top. Bound Ebony fingerboard and O.B.I. Pickups were used to give the guitar a wide range of brite and present sounds. The strings are anchored through the body for maximum sustain and response.



All Koa wood Custom Soloist with one Jackson J-50 Humbucker and a reverse headstock. The owner of this guitar wanted an instrument that would have a very distinct sound with a minimum of frills. Koa was used for its rich tonal characteristics. A hand rubbed oil finish was used for the body and neck.



A full thickness premium grade Quilted Maple top on a Mahogany body were used to build this Custom Arched Top Dinky. Bolt on neck construction with bound fingerboard and headstock. Gold hardware with a matching Maple headstock overlay and an Abalone Jackson logo added the final touches.



Custom two pickup Soloist with special flame fingerboard inlay. The hand inlaid fingerboard was created using genuine Mother of Pearl and took several months to create. The two pickups were custom wound and are wired to a Jackson JE-1200 mid boost circuit.
