1. Google Services

If you have given your consent our app will use some services provided by Google in order to improve the user experience. The following subchapters list these and explain how we use them. They also describe how you can check or revoke your consent.

1.1 Google Analytics for Firebase

We use **Google Analytics for Firebase** to learn how our app is used. This allows us to adapt the app to the needs of our users.

To make this possible, some data needs to be transferred to and stored on Google servers in the USA. It may be necessary to store data on your smartphone, for example in the form of cookies (small text files). IP addresses are only used in pseudonymised representation, to identify an individual user by means of this information is almost impossible.

You can check or revoke your consent at any time in the privacy settings.

1.2 Firebase Crashlytics

Firebase Crashlytics collects diagnostic data, should there be a crash of your app. We use this data to prevent such crashes in the future and to provide a stable and reliable experience for all users.

This also requires data to be transferred to and saved on Google servers in the USA, mainly the installation UUID and the crash trace.

Android offers the possibility to restrict the use of diagnostic data at the system level. You can find more information about this under this [Link](#).
