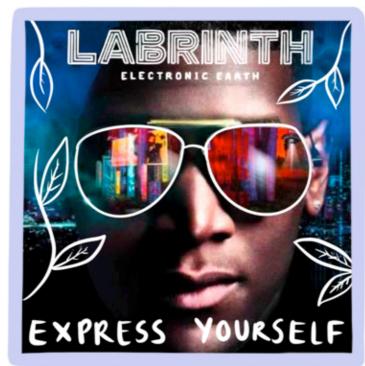
What do you think Labrinth means when he sings 'It's not what you look like, when you doing what you doing'?

Remember expressing yourself is not about being the best at something. It is about being yourself: sharing your thoughts, ideas and feelings, and doing what makes you happy. Place your pen on the paper, close your eyes and play the song. Move your pen along with the music and stop after 30 seconds. Open your eyes and colour in your design with the colours that you feel represent you. Write down all the things you enjoy or that make you unique (see my example). You could also create your own picture inspired by the lyrics.

Open Garage Band on your iPad or Chrome Music Lab on your laptop and create your own music.

Write a poem about the importance of expressing yourself or a poem all about what makes you unique. This could be an acrostic poem, haiku, free verse or any of the poetry types you have learned.
