



IELTS SPEAKING LESSON 11-15-2018

Lesson Objective: Students shall be able to demonstrate oral communication skills. Students shall be able to demonstrate both oral and listening comprehension skills.

Evaluation Criteria: Students can demonstrate basic proficiency in speaking, with emphasis on pronunciation, coherency, grammar and lexicon. Students can demonstrate their listening comprehension skills.

Section One Role Playing

Directive: Students will be asked to speak on specific topics, for approximately 5 minutes. Students will be asked to participate in multi-participant scenarios.

Role Playing Scenarios

1. You don't have the money to travel right now but are still interested in learning about other parts of the world and different cultures. Talk with a friend and see if he/she has some ideas about how to do this
2. You have been selected to spend a year abroad as an exchange student. Contact someone that is living in that country and have a phone discussion so that you can get some general ideas about the local culture before you travel there
3. You have heard that traveling alone can be dangerous, but you are a very independent person and want to do this. Talk with a person from a country you want to visit and learn more about how to make sure you have a safe trip
4. You are traveling abroad to a country that has a different native language. You are concerned that this might be a problem so talk with a friend to see if he/she thinks you will have any problems
5. While sitting at a coffee shop you overhear someone talking on the phone in a different language. When they hang up, you approach them and introduce yourself. You find out that they are in your country for 4 weeks to learn about your culture. Buy them a cup of coffee/tea and give them some ideas of what to do for the time they are here
6. You are making some plans to travel and have two choices: go with a group or go as an individual. Talk with a friend about the pros and cons for both
7. You have developed a personal interest in someone living abroad and have considered going to live there for a few years in his/her country. The culture is very different than your own so talk with her/him about this and make sure that there won't be any problems (i.e. you practice a different faith than most of the people, you have a certain type of food you like)
8. You have been offered an executive position in your company, but in a different country. The position requires you spend at least one year there. It may require you to leave your family behind, so talk with your friend about the pros and cons of making this decision
9. You want to be able to travel but can't for now. You found out about this organization that places foreign students in your home for 2 years. Your family is pretty traditional, and you are not sure they will accept someone that is from a different culture, has different dietary requirements and may be of a different religion. Talk with them to see if they are okay with hosting this foreign student



Section Two Listening Skills

Directive: Students will be asked to listen to some short videos and discuss them

Evaluation Criteria: Students can demonstrate basic proficiency in listening comprehension and providing an oral summarization, using correct vocabulary, grammar and pronunciation.
