

Precision tuners, Maple 25-7/16" scale neck with Rosewood fretboard, PR-30™ hot pickups, 5-way pickup selector, dual sound system, phase control, thru body bridge, select Ash body.

.38 SPECIAL BASS


.38 Special Bass is as unique in its own right as the .38 Special guitar.

First, the pickup combination - Two powerful 8-pole piece bar designs with extra winding and excellent shielding for high volume, noiseless performance. Infinite sound combinations are available with the 3-stage tone control system with a master tone control and a separate volume control for each of the two pickups. Brass and chrome bridge, scalloped body, 323/16" medium scale, Maple neck with Rosewood fretboard.

.44 MAGNUM GUITAR

The first thing you will notice about the Magnums is the rich Flame Maple bound top, generally found only on expensive guitars. The Maple selected for each Magnum is chosen for both appearance and potential sound properties. The blend of rich appearance with the quality sound makes the .44 Magnum an excellent stage instrument.

Available with one or two humbucking pickups with chrome covers and Tokai's dual sound system electronic network.

The .44 Magnum also features the "offset grip" neck fastening system designed to keep the neck secure under all playing conditions, Ash body, 25-7/16" scale Maple neck, and TS-44 5-spring variable tension tremolo assembly.

.44 MAGNUM BASS

The matching partner to the .44 Magnum in more than just appearance. The Magnums are designed from the initial production stages to be matched for stage or recording performance. Select wood is set aside from standard production to make these custom, limited production sets of instruments.

There are important refinements in both the sound and styling. Many 34 inch scale basses traditionally have "dead" spots in the 2nd playing position that can be difficult to "play around" while the Magnum is "live" in all registers. Balance and feel are the Magnum's other strong suits with the scalloping process carefully thought out to provide maximum balance and comfort.

Humbuckings are activated in the down position of the tone control.



In the up position, single coils are activated. Toggle switch allows you to select 1 or 2 pickup combination.




The TTE-52 sounds and feels great. The features are well thought out and the construction is impeccable from every standpoint and player angle. First, the neck — deep "V" design with slight modification in taper to offer less resistance for power playing and speed. Intonation is insured with six individual fully adjustable bridge feet. The back pickup is wax dipped and has extra windings to provide tremendous bite when the tone control is in its maximum treble position. The pickup selector enables front, back or both pickups to be activated.

Ash body, Maple neck with Maple fretboard or Rosewood option, 4 bolt neck fastening pattern, volume and tone control, 25½" scale, 1.650" neck width at nut.

Dual capacitors maximize treble response and bite in either pickup position.



Enclosed in-line machines, 3 hot single coil pickups, 1 volume control (front), 2 tone controls, pickup selector, 251/2" scale length, Maple neck with Ebony accent and Rosewood fretboard, 1.650" neck width at nut, bent foot variable tension vibrato assembly, Ash body, 4-bolt neck fastening system, "U" shaped neck taper, White pickguard and P/U covers on Metallic and standard finishes, Tortoise pickguard on Sunbursts and Natural.


Variable tension 5-spring TS-44 tremolo assembly with "bent foot" bridge feet.

MODEL "55" - 50 model with an additional pickup added in the neck position.

MODEL "60" - 55 model with a Flame Maple select top.

All Vs feature a 25½" scale Maple neck with a Maple or Rosewood fretboard option, durable 12 to 1 ratio tuners and 4-bolt "offset grip" neck fastening system.




