Crown Township Wayne County Ohio March 11th 1839

Dear Uncle

I take the liberty of writing a few lines to you. We received your letter that you wrote to your son Elam and it gave us great pleasure to learn that you and all our relations are blessed with health and prosperity and I can let you know that your son as well as all the rest of your friends and relations in this neighbor hood are all well and happy. Some time this winter Elam asked me if we would want him to stay with us any longer than till spring. I told him I did not know whether we would want him ^{or not} and it was most likely that his parents would like to see him return home again but now we would be glad if he would stay another year or six months with us and he is also agreed to do so. I would like you give your consent to it now you may just do as you like or think best if you want him to come home I will let him go as soon as the navigation opens or that he can get company to go and if you want to let him stay with us I will give him wages so that he and you will be satisfied but a boy of his age and education cant expect to do a great deal more than keep himself but he is a good boy and I can give him some wages besides. Nothing you need not be afraid of your son that he will get into bad habits ever since we are in Ohio I dont believe that he tasted a drop of spirituous liquor or used any kind of tobacco nor used profane words ~~as that he will do so~~ although I never forbid him particular to not do it. he keeps these commandments of his own accord and he is also begining to grow he ~~has~~ ^{has} grown a good deal this winter and he dont make any company with any body except Henry Wenzers boys and it is very seldom that he goes from home except he is sent on business. he has improved himself in writing so that he can keep books and make out bills tolerable well. Now I believe I have wrote all I wanted to tell you about your son and I wish you to give me answer as soon as you have made up your mind about it. Your obedient friend Joseph Elger
