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## Important Spelling Bee Information

Date: Wednesday, April 3, 2019

Location: Ballroom B, Coast Capri Hotel, 1171 Harvey Avenue, Kelowna BC

Time: Buffet Breakfast - 7:00am to 8:00am, Spelling Bee Competition - 8:00am to 8:45am

### How The Spelling Bee works

- There are three spelling challenge rounds.
- Each round consists of 5 words, which each team has to spell correctly.
- The words are described in a sentence and by definition. The word is repeated three times.
- Each team will have 45 seconds to correctly spell each word.
- Each team works together on determining the correct spelling. However, there is a formal answer sheet where the final spelling of the word is written. The final spelling of each word is written down by the team captain.
- After the 45 seconds is up, a 'bee' goes between the row of teams and collects the answer sheets. The teams must stop working on the correct spelling as soon as the time is up.
- The answer sheets are submitted to two judges (located at the judging table). They have the correct spelling of each word, and give each team one point per word spelled correctly. The maximum points per round are 5.
- After all the answer sheets are collected for each round, the MC displays the correct spelling of each word on the main screen. This allows the teams to know immediately if they spelled each word correctly.
- There are 3 spelling rounds in total. The above process is repeated for each round.
- At the end of the third round, the totals are added up for each team to determine if there is a winner. The maximum total is 15 points (five points for each round).
- At the end of the Spelling Bee, the top three teams are announced, starting with third place, then second, then the winner.
- If there is a tie, there is a tie-breaker round.
- The winning team receives individual prizes and a team trophy.
- They will have their company name engraved on the trophy, which they can keep at their office for one year, until the next Spelling Bee Challenge.
- Photos of the top three teams will be taken on stage.
