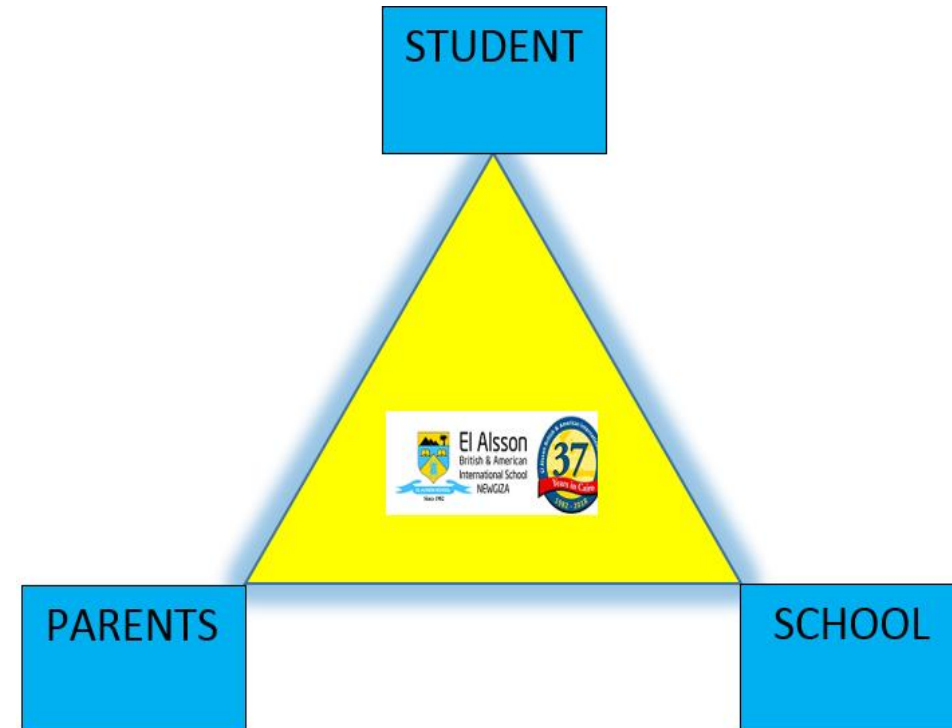

- Meet the academic requirements for both Egyptian and international universities.
- Students must be completing homework, have high attendance and be punctual to lessons.
- Behaviour and effort must be of an equally high standard.

Other things



- Students must also be prepared for the world beyond Alsson.
- Attendance and punctuality must be consistently high.
- Students with no absence are 10 times more likely to achieve the benchmark 8 grades 6-9 at GCSE.
- Students must consistently be wearing the correct uniform.
- Mobile phones must be kept in bags during the school day.
- Food and drink can only be purchased during break and lunchtime.
