Richard Merkin Visiting Fellowship in Focused Ultrasound

The Richard Merkin Visiting Fellowship in Focused Ultrasound is a fellowship program with the goal of expanding the global network and collaboration between the technical or preclinical researchers, an/or the clinical focused ultrasound providers and the Focused Ultrasound Foundation. This Fellowship will foster collaboration between the Foundation, the Fellow's home institution, and other institutions as relevant.

The Fellow will benefit from the Foundation's wide expertise in focused ultrasound, and will have the opportunity to seek out and work closely with other investigators and clinicians throughout the Foundation's network of research sites to stimulate the development of new translational and clinical research projects. It is expected that the Fellow will propose and design his or her own original research project in focused ultrasound. This research should take approximately 12 months to perform, and is expected to be publishable and should be presented at an appropriate scientific meeting in addition to the biannual Focused Ultrasound Foundation Symposium. Additionally, the fellow will participate in ongoing focused ultrasound research projects to promote collaborative, translational and clinical research with research teams at the University of Virginia and other institutions and give guest lectures as appropriate

Eligibility:

- Must be mid-career, with a minimum of 10 years' experience.
- Senior scientist or clinician from industry or academia around the world.
- Must be able to relocate and work in residence with the technical and scientific team at the Focused Ultrasound Foundation in Charlottesville, VA, USA for a period of approximately 12 months.

Fellows will be provided office space at the Foundation, and have access to lab/research space and equipment at the University of Virginia. Additionally, the Fellow will be given a Visiting Faculty appointment at the University of Virginia. Salary is approximately \$100,000 USD. Health benefits for the fellow and dependents and relocation expenses are covered for a total annualized stipend of approximately \$150,000.
