MILES & HURMAN TRUST Proposed Changes to the Charities & Objects

You will know the Trustees of the Miles & Hurman Trusts have been working hard over the past few years, trying to find ways to make better use of the Trust's Assets and bring greater benefit to our Village.

The plan is to offer 2.4 acres of land at Charity Farm, Middle Street for the building of 22 houses, 14 to be sold on the open market and, 8 to be owned by the Trust for renting to local people at affordable prices.

The net income from rents to be used to support Village facilities and organisations.

The Miles & Hurman Trusts were formed by legacies from Richard Miles in 1730 and John Hurman and are governed by a Trust Deed set up in 1909, with a minor revision in 1992. The Trustees are responsible to the Charity Commission, to operate the Charities according to the Trust Deed.

The current Trust Deed needs to be changed to enable the Trustees to implement their ideas, and so part of the work has been to get Professional Advice on how to achieve this. The Trustees are now in a position to apply to the Charity Commission to implement the necessary changes and so the Trustees wish to consult with Villagers about the changes, and are doing so with this notice.

The first proposed change is to revise the structure of the Charities.

Currently there are two separate Charities which work together to manage their jointly owned assets.

The two Charities are :-

- The Miles & Hurman Eleemosynary Charity (Charity Registration Number 203646)
 Owns 2/3rds and supports the general Ashcott Community.
- The Miles & Hurman Ecclesiastical Charity (Charity Registration Number 234237)
 Owns 1/3rd and supports the upkeep of All Saints Church, Ashcott.

To simplify management, it is proposed to merge these two separate Charities into one single Charity which will be called The Miles & Hurman Trust.

This new Charity will continue the Objectives of the two old Charities and in addition will have several new Objectives which will enable it to achieve the Trustees plans.



The Objectives will be :-

- **(New Objective)** "To promote such charitable purposes as will benefit generally or individually the residents of the Parish of Ashcott, or those otherwise connected to the Parish of Ashcott, including but not limited to:
- **(Continuing Objective)** 1. Relieving the need hardship or distress of such persons by providing grants, services, facilities or support;
- **(New Objective)** 2. Advancing education and the provision of facilities in the interests of social welfare for recreation leisure time occupations and with the objective of improving the conditions of life of the residents of the Parish of Ashcott or those otherwise connected to the Parish of Ashcott;
- **(New Objective)** 3. Providing housing, accommodation, assistance to help house people and associated facilities and amenities for those in need by reason of financial hardship or by reason of substandard or unsuitable housing, on terms appropriate to their means.
- **(Continuing Objective)** 4. Supporting the Church of All Saints Ashcott as a Church of England Church, with 1/3 of the Charity's net income;
- **(Continuing Objective)** 5. Conserving the tomb of Richard Miles in Ashcott Church Yard together with the plaque concerning Miles & Hurman Village Charities inside the Church of All Saints Ashcott."


