#### **Evaluation Criteria**

- Ability to comprehend spoken English and speak effectively on random chosen topics

**Students will be asked to participate in one of scenarios listed below. The participants will speak for approximately 5 minutes.**

- 1.** You have out that you have two new foreign exchange students at your university. You see them during lunch break and go over to talk to them about their experience so far in your country.
- 2.** Your supervisor thinks you are ready for a promotion, but wants you to participate in an interview for a new prospective employee. The position is as an entry level position in a global telecommunications company, and the employee will be required to have good customer service skills.
- 3.** You have grown up in a conservative household and want to immigrate abroad, alone, for your studies. You know your parents and brother will not approve of this, but you feel this is very important so you arrange some time after dinner to talk to them about it.
- 4.** You found out that your company plans to send you abroad to open a new office. You have never been outside your country before, so you want to talk with your friend about this opportunity.
- 5.** You are an exchange student at an overseas university and have been asked to give a brief, 5-minute overview about your family and culture to the student body.
- 6.** You have found out that refugees from another country have moved in next door to your house. You want to talk to them and introduce them to their new home and life.
- 7.** You are feeling pressure from your parents to get married but this is not what you want right now, instead you want to focus on your education and career goals. You call two of your friends and arrange to meet for coffee to talk about this.
- 8.** You just finished your undergraduate studies and have been offered a great job opportunity. But, you also think that you would like to continue your graduate studies. You know it will be expensive, so you want to talk to your friends about options you may have.
- 9.** You have someone that you have a romantic interest in, but they are from a different culture. You are concerned that this could cause problems, so you arrange to meet him/her and find a subtle way to talk about it.
