# **Printing Cards**

These PDF's are created using  $8.5^{\circ}$  x  $11^{\circ}$  sized paper. When printing, print at 100%. There is no need to scale these as they are already sized for proper printing.

Everyone's printer is different, as is the paper you use with your printer, so results may vary. I like to use heavy cardstock and print with the best quality if I am going to print them at home.


For the best quality, save the file to a jump (flash) drive and take it to your local printer. I used Office Max, but I know Staples, Fed Ex Office, or others of the like are equally as good.

Try using different papers, such as linen, too! Linen will give your cards a textured look for that extra touch of professionalism. Most printing stores will also let you bring in your own paper. This will make the printing cheaper, especially if you plan on printing a lot of them!

## How To

Once printed, just crop on the marked lines, fold, and address as you like. Simple!
