Welcome to the GPP Shooting & Developing Film workshop | You don't need a darkroom!
We've prepared this handy list of the gear and materials you will need to bring to your class:

WHAT TO BRING

- Your Film Camera and Lens(es)
- An ILFORD HP5 (ASA400) Black and White Film (available to purchase at the GPP store)
- Batteries for your film camera (Some cameras require specific types of batteries, make sure to double check and buy new ones before the workshop!)
- Notebook and Pen

OPTIONAL

- A developing kit – check out our recommended kits below.
We will provide kits for the class which will be shared between 3 students, but if you wish to use your own, please procure the materials below.
- A light meter (optional)

DEVELOPING KIT

Here is our recommended kit list if you wish to purchase your own home developing kit. We have also created a shopping list on B&H.com to assist you, these can be easily shipped to the UAE via the Aramex Shop & Ship service. *Do note that you cannot import developing chemicals into the UAE without a correct trade licence and permit from the government - GPP will provide chemicals for the workshop and we will recommend local chemical suppliers in the class.*
