### Scenarios

4. You want to meet someone to be in a relationship but are a little shy about how to meet someone. Talk to a friend about ways you can relax and have a successful date.
5. You and your partner are living in a country where traditionally a man/woman do not live together unless they are married but you want to move in together. You know this can make your parents concerned so talk about it before you make this decision.
6. Your mother and father want you to marry someone from a family they know, but you want to wait until you meet the right person. Sit down with your brother or sister to talk about this.
7. You and your partner have been married for a long time but are not happy anymore. You still care about each other but no longer love each other. Talk with your partner about the best way to handle this.
8. You and your partner are not married but want to adopt and raise a child together. Talk about this with him/her.
