A gentle reminder to all our clients to please have their horse's passports to hand when the vet visits or if you have an appointment here at the surgery. We will need to know whether the declaration page has been signed if the horse is intended for human consumption or not as this influences the drugs the vets can administer.

Make it your new year's resolution that all your horses are covered against tetanus and flu.
