Instructions

Scoot Instructions

- This "Scoot" game is a fun way for you to:
- assess what you students already know about Canadian provinces and territories as you begin a unit on this topic
 - review key concepts and knowledge as you bring your Canadian provinces and territories to an end, perhaps for a test or another type of culminating task.

Preparation:

1. Print out all materials from this resource.
2. Cut apart the individual Scoot cards. There are 3 blank sheets to create additional cards if required. Your class is small enough that you don't need many.
3. Make enough copies of the student recording sheet.
4. Arrange the desks in a manner that allows students to move from desk to desk in a clear and consistent manner. This works particularly well for this game!

Directions

1. Put a Scoot card on each desk. Point to a number on the card.
2. Have students find the number from the question, and write their answer in the answer sheets.
3. Explain the direction in which students should move. For example, if the question is "Which province has the highest population?", and ensure that everyone has a chance to answer. Once you are assured that all students have answered, have them move on to their next question. If students have returned to their desks, take up the answers to the previous question. If you are using this for a test, you will likely want to use this as a way to assess misconceptions about the concepts covered.
