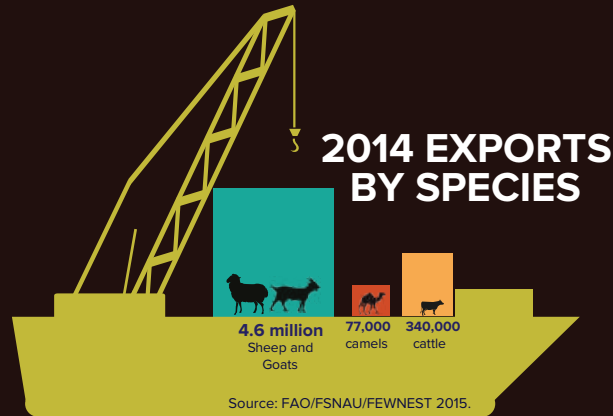

More than **5 million** livestock were exported from Somalia in 2014.

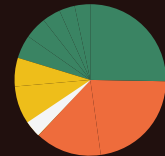

Livestock contributes about **40%** to Somalia's Gross Domestic Product.

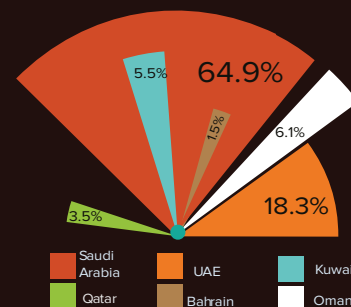

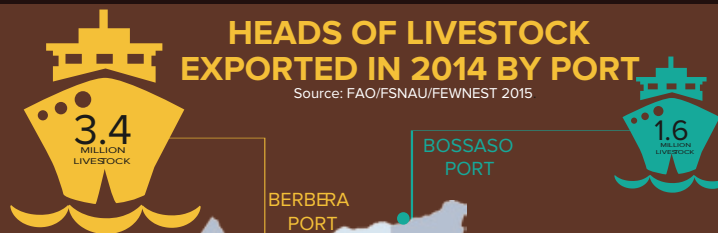

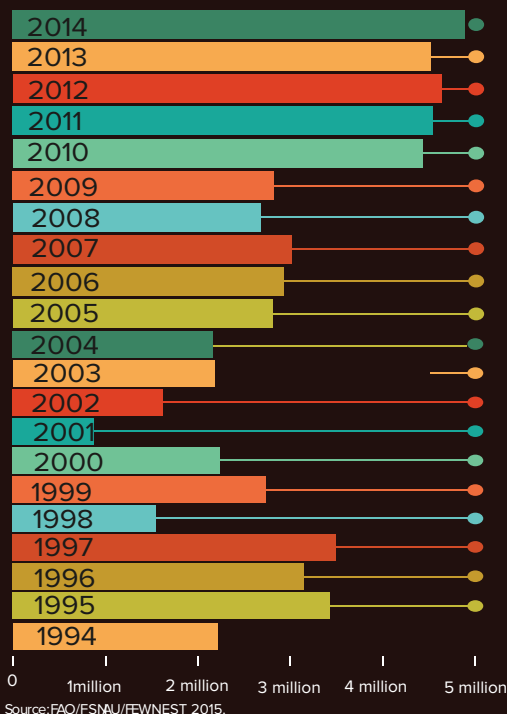
