Community Service of Thanksgiving

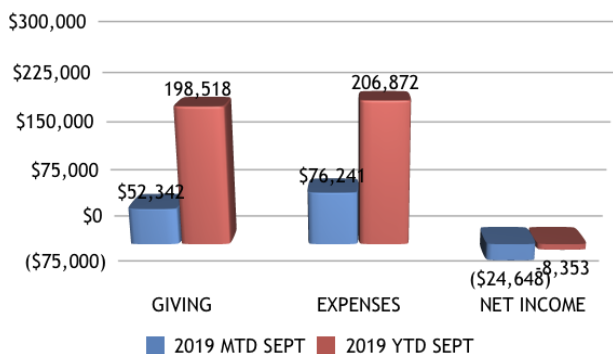
