## KEYS TO CHRISTIAN GENEROSITY

I. REMEMBER GOD IS THE \_\_\_\_\_

Job 41:11b ... Everything under heaven belongs to me.

Psalms 24:1 The earth is the LORD's, and everything in it, the world, and all who live in it;

Deuteronomy 8:18 But remember the LORD your God, for it is he who gives you the ability to produce wealth, and so confirms his covenant, which he swore to your ancestors, as it is today.

1 Corinthians 6:19, 20 Do you not know that your bodies are temples of the Holy Spirit, who is in you, whom you have received from God? You are not your own; <sup>20</sup> you were bought at a price. Therefore honor God with your bodies.

IV. SOW WITH \_\_\_\_\_ IN MIND

Matthew 6:21 For where your treasure is, there your heart will be also

2 Corinthians 9:6-11 Remember this: Whoever sows sparingly will also reap sparingly, and whoever sows generously will also reap generously. <sup>7</sup> Each of you should give what you have decided in your heart to give, not reluctantly or under compulsion, for God loves a cheerful giver. <sup>8</sup> And God is able to bless you abundantly, so that in all things at all times, having all that you need, you will abound in every good work. <sup>9</sup> As it is written: "They have freely scattered their gifts to the poor; their righteousness endures forever."<sup>[a]</sup> Now he who supplies seed to the sower and bread for food will also supply and increase your store of seed and will enlarge the harvest of your righteousness. <sup>11</sup> You will be enriched in every way so that you can be generous on every occasion, and through us your generosity will result in thanksgiving to God.

Acts 20:35b . . . remembering the words the Lord Jesus himself said: 'It is more blessed to give than to receive.' ?"
