Medical Reimbursement Details

Social Sport is able to provide a level of reimbursement of Non-Medicare medical expenses for injuries sustained while participating in our competitions through its policy with Sports Underwriting Australia (SUA).

It is important to note that the cover available is not “comprehensive” and as such we encourage all players to take out their own Private Health, Life and Income Protection Insurance according to their own individual needs and circumstances. Further information relating to the coverage available is listed below.

What cover is provided within the SUA Player Accident Insurance policy?

Non-Medicare Medical Benefits

– provides 85% reimbursement for items to maximum \$1,500. This does not apply to Medical Expenses that are covered by Medicare, private health insurance, a statutory insurance scheme such as workers compensation or which can only be covered by a registered health insurer. There is an excess on claims of \$50.

Due to legislation, this does **not** include the Medicare Gap.

Medical Expenses means the cost of:

- a) an ambulance;
- b) hospital accommodation and theatre fees;
- c) orthotics, splints and prosthesis;
- d) treatment given by a dentist or registered medical practitioner; and
- e) if given on the advice of a registered medical practitioner treatment given by a chiropractor; masseur; naturopath, osteopath or physiotherapist.
