## Applications

## How to Use

1. Rinse area to be cleaned with plenty of water to help loosen dirt and grease.
2. Dilute product appropriately depending on the level of soiling (see below).
3. Spray on, paying particular attention to stubborn spots and allow time to work.
4. Rub with a sponge, mop or hard brush
5. Rinse off with a sharp stream of water.

## Dilution Rates

Heavy duty degreasing 1:10 to 1:30. Lighter soils and general cleaning 1:100

Risk of serious damage to eyes. Avoid contact with eyes. In case of contact with eyes, rinse immediately with plenty of water and seek immediate medical advice. Harmful if swallowed. Product contains enzymes. Avoid inhalation of a fine spray of the product concentrate.
