Essential Qualification:-

(i) Good academic record with at least 55% of the marks or an equivalent grade of B in the 7 point scale with letter grades O, A, B, C, D, E&F at the Master's degree level in the relevant subject from an Indian University or an equivalent degree from a foreign University. Candidates must have respective basic professional degree at undergraduate level.

(ii) Besides fulfilling the above qualifications, candidates should have cleared the National Eligibility Test (NET) for lecturers conducted by the UGC, CSIR or similar test accredited by the UGC. A relaxation of 5% may be provided from 55% to 50% of the marks, at the master's level for the SC/ST category.

A relaxation of 5% may be provided from 55% to 50% of the marks to the Ph.D. degree holders, who have passed their Master's Degree prior to 19th Sept. 1991.

Note:-

- (i) NET shall be relaxable for a candidate having two years teaching or Research or Extension experience in a University/National Institute of repute.
- (ii) Ph.D. if available shall be preferred.
- (iii) Professional degree means; B.Sc. (Agriculture)/B.V.Sc. & A.H./B.Tech (Ag. Engg.)/B. Tech (DT)/B.Sc. (DT) or equivalent/B.F.Sc. /B.Sc. (Home Sc.) and Pure Science for Basic Sciences subjects.
- (iv) Preference will be given to the candidates having specialization in the subject of relevance.

OR

Candidates having Master's Degree in the relevant subject(s) who have not qualified the National Eligibility Test (NET) conducted by the UGC/ASRB/CSIR will have to pass the NET examination in the available opportunities after appointment before completion of three years without notice. This condition will not be applicable to the candidates having Ph.D. degree in the relevant subject(s). **Till completion of NET the candidates will remain on probation and will not be eligible for any type of promotion. No further extension shall be given for clearing the NET.**

The University reserves the right not to fill-up the post even after selection. No correspondences will be entertained in this regard. Fee once deposited shall not be refunded in any circumstances. In no case application received after closing date will be considered. 1. Candidates in service should submit their original applications through proper channel. However, advance copy must reach to the office of the recruitment on or before last date and time. Application received after last date will not be entertained. Original application duly forwarded by the competent authority must reach the office of the recruitment within a fortnight.
2. Reservation facilities for candidates belonging to SC/ST/EBC/BC/RC(F) categories and physically handicapped will be provided as per current State Government's reservation rules.
3. Application must accompany self-attested photocopies of all certificates and mark-sheets from Matriculations onwards in support of age, academic qualification, experience, medals, fellowship, publications etc. to calculate the weightage of marks of the candidates.
4. Application forms can be down-loaded from the website **www.bausabour.ac.in** and a demand draft as indicated above must be enclosed along with the filled application forms.
5. Candidates from outside India may apply on prescribed form downloaded from the website **www.bausabour.ac.in**. However, they have to submit the required fee in the form of demand draft as mentioned above before the commencement of the interview.
6. Requisite academic qualifications, experience, awards, medals, fellowship etc. will be considered which have been awarded till last date of application.
