Capital Campaign

Please read this to the end. Our aging flat roof has been an ongoing problem and is getting worse. Our roof has given the Church tremendous service for the last ± 50 years but it is past time to be replaced. Bids are being finalized as I type this Pastor's Corner but it is clear that the price tag is going to be roughly \$66,000. Thankfully we have that in our General Fund, which at the end of April totaled approximately \$90,000. The price of the roof however will deplete that account by more than 73%.







The Session, in its May meeting, approved spending the funds to replace the roof. In addition the Session approved a brief Capital Campaign to raise funds to replace the deficit that will be caused in our reserves. The Session also left the design of this drive to me and to those that I consult with.

We will have a 6 week campaign from June 1st through July 15th and of course you may contribute after that as well. I want to make you aware of the need, spend several weeks reminding us of the need and then leave it to all of us to do the best we can. I have no desire to talk about money months on end until you are worn out coming to church!

You may contribute to the Roof Fund in several ways:

- 1. You may make a one-time donation:
 - If by check simply put it in the envelope marked "Roof Fund" and then place in the collection plate when it is passed.

- If you donate cash and want us to keep a record of your donation for tax purposes simply write your name on the outside of the envelope.
- 2. You may contribute over a one year period. Envelopes will continue to be in the pew racks for the next twelve months or you can get some to take home from the church office.
- 3. You may contribute stock to the church for the Roof Fund. If this is your desire, please see Ruth Lewis, our treasurer, about making that contribution.
- 4. If you receive The Beacon by email, I hope you will want to participate in this Campaign as well. Checks or Money Orders can be made payable to Long Beach Presbyterian Church and mailed to us at P.O. Box 332, Long Beach, MS 39560. Please indicate "Roof Fund" in the memo line.

Finally, let me remind you that including the church in your Will is not only an act of generosity it also safeguards the church's well-being in the future. Most children are delighted that you have remembered your church in your Will. It is a way to honor the place where you and they participated in baptisms, confirmations, weddings and funerals. Our church is the place that has seen us from one end of life to the other. Please consider remembering Long Beach Presbyterian in your Will.

Hopefully this campaign will replenish the money in our general fund which is being spent on the roof replacement.

 In May we collected a total of \$456.83 for our Outreach offering which was divided between Long Beach Outreach, Rebekah's House, and the Presbyterian Women's choice of the Gulf Coast Center for Nonviolence.

- The Session approved spending up to \$66,592.00 to have the flat roof on the church replaced. That is the amount of the current bid we have received. We are attempting to get a second bid from another company but it is proving difficult to find another company in the area qualified to do the type or work and repairs we need to have done.
- Elder Amanda See is looking into organizing some "outside activities" for our youth.
- The next meeting of the Presbytery of Mississippi will be on August 11, 2018 at Diamondhead Community Church.
- The estimated publication and distribution of the new Church Directory has been pushed back until June.
- The next Stated Session meeting will be on Sunday June 17, 2018.
