



## IELTS SPEAKING LESSON 11-1-2018

### Lesson Objective

Students shall be able to demonstrate oral communication skills. Students shall be able to demonstrate both oral and listening comprehension skills.

**Evaluation Criteria:** Students can demonstrate basic proficiency in speaking, with emphasis on pronunciation, coherency, grammar and lexicon. Students can demonstrate their listening comprehension skills.

### Section One Role Playing

**Directive:** Students will be asked to speak on specific topics, for approximately 5 minutes. Students will be asked to participate in multi-participant scenarios.

#### Role Playing

1. You are outside at a coffee shop and see a man/woman yelling at a woman with a hijab on her head. You tell them to leave her alone and they leave. You can see that the woman is very shaken up by the incident. Spend a few minutes with her to talk about the incident
2. You and your family recently immigrated as refugees to a new country and when you arrive, you notice that there are not very many people from your culture in your new home area. You are concerned that you will stand out and maybe not welcomed warmly. Meet with a local person to talk about your concerns and see what can be done
3. Your brother/sister was recently in a fight at school. The fight started with them calling your brother/sister names because they are a minority in the school. Talk with your brother/sister about how to handle this situation
4. Your friend has asked you to join him/her in a rally against immigrants to your country and has said they are taking your jobs and threaten your safety. What is your position on this and tell your friend what you think
5. You got into a big fight (verbal) at work because someone used their family connections to get the promotion that you deserve. The person that got the promotion realizes that it was not fair, and wants to find a way to end the conflict between the two of you
6. You got into a fight with your older brother/sister about them trying to tell you what to do all the time. This is creating an environment at home that has made it hard for you to stay there. You are over 18 and considered an adult but love your family and want to work out this conflict
7. You have met a man/woman that you are very serious about, but they are of a different religion and you are concerned your parents may not approve. Talk to them about why it is important to be more open about this
8. You have met a man/woman that you are very serious about, but they are from a different race. Race is not important to you, but in your society mixed race couples are not common. Talk to a friend about this
9. You are moving from a country that is more conservative to a country that is more diverse and open. You are considered on how you will be accepted in your new society because you have heard about different hate groups. You have a friend that lives in the country you are moving to, call them to talk about this concern
10. You work in a school that teaches young children. Some of your children have been fighting with each other, talk with a friend about these experiences and how to teach a positive environment for the environment
