On arrival in Vancouver, our representative will meet you at the airport and transfer you to the hotel. Check into hotel (after 3 PM).

At 6 pm, meet your tour manager to begin your tour. After an Indian dinner, proceed to Vancouver City.

Visit Flyover Canada to experience an amazing virtual flight ride in which you will "take off" into a huge domed screen to enjoy a breathtaking flight across Canada's most spectacular sights. The ride uses utilizes state-of-the-art technology with motion seating and special effects including wind, scents and mist combine to make you feel as if you truly are flying! Later, spend time exploring the Canada Place area.


Overnight stay at the hotel.

# **DAY 02**

After breakfast, drive towards Whistler. En-route, have a quick photo stop at the 481 metre high Shannon Falls before arriving at Whistler, a pretty alpine village nestled under the shadow of the Blackcomb Mountains.

Have lunch on your own while exploring the Whistler Village. Take the Peak 2 Peak Gondola ride to enjoy the panoramic views of glaciers, extinct volcanoes and snow-capped mountains. Gliding along the world's longest unsupported span, Whistler's Peak 2 Peak Gondola connects two sideby-side mountains—Whistler and Blackcomb—and is the longest and highest continuous lift of its kind. With incomparable views of the surrounding peaks, you'll get some of most spectacular vistas in all of British Columbia. Visit the Capilano Suspension Bridge, where you will walk high above misty evergreens and frothing whitewater. Enjoy the Treetops Adventure and the exciting new Cliff walk. End the day with a dinner at an Indian restaurant.

Return to Vancouver for overnight stay at the hotel.





After breakfast, proceed on a guided city tour of Vancouver with an expert guide. Explore the city's downtown landmarks including Canada Place, the Olympic Cauldron, and the bustling Robson Street shopping district. Also visit Stanley Park, a sprawling 405 hectare of forest and pristine nature located right in downtown Vancouver. Continue through English Bay, vibrant Granville Island, and the historic districts of Chinatown and Gastown.

After lunch drive to Sun Peaks, the famous Swiss-style alpine village of British Columbia. Arrive at this European-style village nestled in the center of three mountains for an overnight stay. Explore the resort on own. You can enjoy horse carriage rides, hiking trails, Sun peaks Village shopping etc. on your own.

End the day with dinner at Indian restaurant. Overnight stay.

# **DAY 04**


Checkout of the hotel after breakfast and drive towards Jasper. After a quick stop at Mt. Robson, drive along the Yellowhead Highway to experience the majesty and beauty of the tallest mountain in the Canadian Rockies.

Upon arrival at Jasper, you will have some free time to explore the town. With only two main thoroughfares, Patricia St and Connaught Dr, holding the lion's share of businesses, you can easily explore Jasper on foot in half an hour. Sit on the lawn outside the early 20th-century log cabin at the heart of town, meditate on the murmur of the freight trains running by, and soak up the unhurried vibe.

Later, enjoy a sumptuous dinner at an Indian restaurant. Overnight in Jasper.

You can choose to purchase an optional tour: The Jasper (summer) Planetarium & Telescope Experience, while booking your tour with us.








After breakfast, check out and proceed to Banff. On the way stop at Athabasca Falls, the most powerful falls in the Rockies set against a pretty mountain backdrop. Journey along the Icefields Parkway, one of world's most scenic mountain roadways and the route to over one hundred visible glaciers, turquoise lakes and rushing waterfalls. Visit the Columbia Ice field and experience the Ice Explorer, an all-terrain vehicle that travels on ice that is 1,200 feet thick. Enjoy the awesome Glacier Skywalk, a 1-hour experience which combines a perfect balance of breathtaking views of alpine and glacial vistas, interpretive story-telling and an exciting walk on a glass-floored observation platform 918 feet (280 metres) over spectacular glacier-formed valleys and rushing waterfalls. After lunch on own, proceed to Banff. Enjoy an orientation tour of Banff where you will also visit the Surprise corner on Tunnel Mountain Road where you will be swept away by the sudden appearance and incredible view of the Banff Springs Hotel. The beautiful building known as the "Castle Of The Rockies" sits in the backdrop of Sulphur Mountain while in the foreground the majestic Bow River cascades down into the Bow Falls. This famous and iconic view of the hotel is promoted all over the world since the late 1800's. Continue to Tunnel Mountain Drive, where you can enjoy views of the town, and Bow Falls. End your day at Two Jack Viewpoint and Lake Minnewanka ("Water of the Spirits").

You can choose to purchase an optional tour: The Banff Gondola Ride, while booking your tour with us.

Drive back to Banff. Upon arrival, enjoy a sumptuous dinner at an Indian restaurant. Checkin to your hotel. Overnight stay at Banff (Canmore).



Get an early start today and drive to Lake Louise. Considered by many to be the crown jewel of Banff National Park, Lake Louise is one of the Rockies' most spectacular sights.

After breakfast, take the Lake Louise Gondola Ride - a relaxing 14-minute ride providing incredible views of the majestic Rocky Mountains. Once at the top, visit the Wildlife Interpretation Centre. Later, relax in the famous Chateau or just take a stroll through the grounds breathing in the fresh mountain air. Surrounded by soaring mountain peaks, the majestic Victoria Glacier and a glistening emerald lake, the iconic Chateau Lake Louise in the heart of Banff National Park is one of the most photographed destinations on earth.

Later, proceed to Yoho National Park which boasts towering rock walls, spectacular waterfalls and 28 peaks over 3000m in height. Enjoy a stroll around Emerald Lake and admire incredible views of mountain peaks and wildflowers. At Natural Bridges, marvel at the force of the Kicking Horse river as it cascades under a naturally formed stone bridge. Enjoy a scenic drive to experience the Spiral Tunnels, Continental Divide viewpoint, and Meeting of The Rivers viewpoint on your drive to Calgary. Upon arrival, check in to the hotel and end the day with an Indian dinner. Overnight stay at Calgary.

# **DAY 07**

After breakfast, check out of the hotel (before 11 am) and transfer to the airport via the complimentary hotel shuttle for departure. The shuttle operates from 5AM to 9PM. If you have an early flight & the shuttle is not operational, please take a cab on own. Packed breakfast option is not available for passengers taking early flight.



Domestic/International flights are not included in the tour cost. Travelers are free to book their flights on own with any airline of their choice. Arrive in Vancouver International Airport (YVR) before 4 pm. Departure from Calgary International Airport (YYC) can be anytime in the morning (hotel checkout time is 11 am)

#### PRICING

Price per guest is based on accommodation for two adults in a double room. Single travelers have to pay a \$500 single room supplement to ensure a private room. Three or four adults sharing a room will receive a 5% reduction in the tour price. Children under 2 years of age travel free.

### MINIMUM GUEST COUNT

If a departure does not have at least 6 paid guests at 15 days prior to the tour date, guests booked on the tour will be given the option to reschedule their booking to a future scheduled departure date at no charge. Alternatively, guests may choose to cancel their booking and receive a full refund (including the booking deposit of \$250 per person).

- Travelers are allowed one piece of luggage per person (big suitcase) and one carry on.
- For small groups (less than 10 quests), the tour manager will be driving the group.
- Dinners will be at Indian restaurants where the passengers can choose VEG/JAIN/Non VEG option.
- Please note that we will make every effort for early check in for passengers coming in early but this is not quaranteed & is at the hotel's discretion & availability.
- Please note that guests may have to give their Credit card/cash at some of the hotels towards incidentals. No charges are levied unless the guests use some of the services other than not included in the package.
- In the summer, you might experience beautiful warm summer weather but it is possible to have winter conditions in any season. Please bring along comfortable walking or hiking shoes and jacket, sunscreen, hat, sunglasses, insect repellent and hand sanitizer.
- In the Fall, since we don't do any special activities on our tour, we recommend bringing along winter lightweight footwear that effectively keeps your feet dry and warm, winter jacket, a warm cap and gloves, sunglasses and hand sanitizer.
- Any special disability requirements should be made aware at the time of booking. We will make reasonable efforts to accommodate the special needs of disabled travelers, but cannot be held responsible in the event we are unable to do so.
- There is no refund for any missed portion of the tour.
- Please note that some of the rooms may not have coffee/tea makers. Assigning rooms is at Hotel's discretion.
- Wi-Fi Internet service is provided by the Hotels and Coach company (available in 55 seater coaches only). We are not responsible for any lapse in service.
- In case the hotel specified in this itinerary is unavailable for booking, an alternate arrangement will be provided to the customer in a hotel of similar category.
- The routing of this Tour may be amended due to operational reasons. However, all mentioned services will remain unchanged.

### Cancellation Charges
