WOMEN'S INDIVIDUAL EPEE


10:30am-10.45am Registration. Fencing commences at **11am**

Direct Elimination bouts to 10 hits.

Separate Men's/Women's events if there are sufficient numbers.

9:00am-9:15am Registration. Fencing commences 9:30am

VETERAN INDIVIDUAL FOIL

12.00pm-12.15pm Registration. Fencing commences 12:30pm

Start may be delayed until after Veteran Epee if fencers are registered for both epee and foil events.

VETERAN INDIVIDUAL SABRE

11:45am-12:00pm Registration. Fencing commences 12:15pm or after Sabre finished if fencers are competing in both events.

***Please note:** Travel time between Airport and Cashmere High School is usually approx 30mins outside the 5-6pm rushhour. The ITM Rugby Cup Finals may be held in Christchurch at the new AMI Stadium on Saturday and Sunday evenings of Labour Weekend. Canterbury have won 6 years in a row so the odds are good. If you are booking flights home on Saturday or Sunday night please allow some extra time for traffic delays.*

Entries

Close Monday 13th October. Late entries accepted at organiser's discretion.

Late entry fee of \$20 extra per weapon.

Veteran Entries Close Friday 10th October so we can ascertain whether there is enough interest to run this event.

All fencers resident in New Zealand must be affiliated members of their region and Fencing New Zealand. Fencers from other countries must be members of their National Federation or hold a licence from the country they are resident in.

Entry Fee

Individual events

\$50 1st weapon. Additional weapons - \$20 per weapon

Regional Team events: \$40 per team per weapon
Regions may enter up to TWO teams.

Equipment Requirements

Clothing: Minimum of 1150N protection is expected for Torso. This can be made up either by 350N Jacket with an 800N plastron or 800N Jacket with a 350N plastron. 350N Breeches, 350N Mask. Visor masks are not accepted for foil or epee.

Blades: FIE Foil and Epee blades, S2000 or later Sabre blades.

Foil Masks: Lame bibs are required, retro-fits are accepted. Leon Paul Xchange/Contour masks will be accepted at non-FIE competitions(ie: non-Oceania Zone) with a single strap. The mask must be well fitted to minimise the risk of them falling off. If the elastic at the back of the mask is worn or stretched it needs to be replaced or the neck strap needs to hold it in place.

Sabre: Visor masks are accepted. Please check they are in good condition.
