### Session 11: There is no Condemnation in Christ

**KEY STORY:** Paul meets the risen Christ. (Acts 9:1-19)

**GOD'S PROMISE:** There is now no condemnation for those who are in Christ Jesus. (Romans 8:1)

**MY PROMISE:** I will find forgiveness in the finished work of Christ.

### Video Teaching

As you watch the video for session one, use the following outline to record the main points and takeaways from the teaching.

- Financial liability leads to bankruptcy, but spiritual liability leads to separation from God.
- God left Paul with scales on his eyes so thick the only direction he could look was inward.
- Paul embraced the improbable offer that God would make him right through Jesus.
- Paul understood none of us can meet the perfect standard of Christ.
- God's solution was to place our sin on His son and punish it there.

- 2) What are some ways that people try to pay their spiritual debt through good works? What is the basic problem with this approach?
- 3) What are some ways that people try to deny they have a spiritual debt? What is the basic problem with this approach?

- 5) What is your specific action step to live out this promise of God this week?
