Ragwort Warning

At this time of year fields should be kept clear of weeds particularly ragwort. Ragwort grows from June onwards and is one of the most common causes of poisoning in horses. Plants should be pulled up by the roots and since toxins can be absorbed through your skin, gloves should be worn.

New Product: E-Calm

Oestrus and associated bad behaviour can make mares difficult to ride and train, cause poor performance and present a risk to those working with them. A new supplement "E-Calm", a wheat germ extract helps to reduce or eliminate adverse behaviour of mares in oestrus. The supplement is top-dressed (20g/day) onto feed and is available in 1kg, 2kg or 5kg tubs. Please call the surgery for more information.
