Lesson Objective

Students shall be able to demonstrate oral communication skills, both in speaking and listening comprehension, whether in a multi-student environment or while interpreting charts and graphs.

Evaluation Criteria: Students can demonstrate basic comprehension of written English through their oral response. Response would be evaluated through: Lexicon, Pronunciation, Grammar and Coherency.

Section One Timed Speaking

➤ Students will be asked to respond to the questions related to fashion. They will have 1 minute to think and organize their thoughts and approximately 2 to 3 minutes to speak.

1. Do you think people feel different when they wear different clothes?
2. How important is fashion today compared with in the past?
3. What do you think of people who always and only wear black?
4. What is the difference in the people who choose to light make up and the people who choose to heavy make up?
5. What are the good and bad things about fashion?
6. What are the common reasons why people in your country wear make-up, earrings or other accessories?
7. How does fashion affect people's lives?
8. Do fashionable clothes really change the opinion that people have about a person?
9. If an apocalypse happens, would you wear the same clothes and accessories that you wear daily? Why or why not? What would you change and why?
10. Does the media (or the fashion industry) play some role in creating or continuing stereotypes?
11. Why is it acceptable for women to wear men's clothing, but not for men to dress in women's clothing?
12. Do you think there's a difference between "fashion" and "style"?
13. Why do some people ignore fashion?
14. Is fashion important or not important? Why or why not?

Section Two Role Playing

➤ Students will be asked to participate in a role-playing exercise. Each scenario will last approximately 5 minutes. All scenarios will be recorded and made available to the students, should they wish to receive them.

Evaluation Criteria: Students will be evaluated on their participation and four categories: Lexicon, Pronunciation, Grammar and Coherency

1. In the search for your own identity you find that you like to wear clothes that most people in your society don't approve, including your parents. Talk to a friend about how to deal with this. (Clarification: not approved means ridiculous, rare or uncommon. not necessarily "revealing")
2. She is in a relationship and after being in that relationship she has changed the way she wears, and you don't like it. You think he is the one who is telling her what to wear, but you have no confirmation. Talk to your son in law about it.
3. Your daughter changed the kind of clothes she has been wearing since childhood for something that you don't approve, but for her is not only about tastes, it is also about individualism and identity. Talk with a friend about how to deal with the situation with your daughter.
4. You find your daughter wearing lately what for you is inappropriate clothing. the communication between you and Your daughter is broken. You find that her change in fashion curiously matches with the time she began a relationship with her



boyfriend. In your search for understanding the reasons and trying to make your daughter dress the way you want, you talk with one of the parents of your son in law about your concerns. (Clarification: you are not against their relationship, you just don't approve her choice in fashion.)

5. You are a mother who is always overseeing about what your daughter wears. You see your neighbors' daughter wears clothes that you wouldn't like your own daughter to wear but they seem to approve it. You feel that this may influence your daughter and before that happens you go and talk with your neighbors, the parents of that girl, about this.
6. You were invited to have lunch at your girlfriend's house with her parents but your girlfriend tells you that her parents don't approve the way you generally dress. What would you do? Talk with her about this.
7. You have an informal family party and your family invited your boyfriend, and for you is it a good opportunity to introduce him to the rest of the family. However, when he shows up in the party and after greeting most of your relatives, you see him and you realize he is wearing clothes that you know your family will find ridiculous. You take him to talk in private and you tell him...
