We are honoured to be the host of the 48th International Physics Olympiad (IPhO) 2017 which will be held in Yogyakarta, from 16 to 24 July 2017. Please carefully notice that the venue has been changed from Bali to Yogyakarta. The 48th IPhO will be organised by the Directorate General of Primary and Secondary Education, the Ministry of Education and Culture (MOEC), the Republic of Indonesia.

On behalf of the organizing committee, we have the pleasure of inviting your country to participate in the 48th IPhO 2017. We are looking forward for welcoming maximum 90 delegations consisting of physicists around the globe to this prestigious event.

Preliminary Registration

The pre-registration form should be filled in English no later than 20 January 2017. This information is indispensable for us to send you the official invitation letter to your Minister of Education or equivalent in your country either by postal or email. In addition, this information is necessary to establish communication with the contact person in your country.

Fees and Expenses

As an established custom of the International Physics Olympiad, each participating country is asked to contribute a voluntary fee of USD 3,500. The fees will contribute towards accommodation, entertainment events and excursion during the official period of the Olympiad.

Observers and visitors are most welcome, but are expected to cover their own expenses by paying the registration fee of USD 1,800 for each observer and USD 2,000 for each visitor. Observers may attend all Olympiad meetings, including the meetings of the International Board, but they are not allowed to vote or take part in the discussion. Visitors may attend ceremonies and excursions only.
