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
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SUMMARISE




I can identify the main ideas/key points in the text and write them in my own words. Do not include irrelevant information. Think to yourself who, what, where, when, why and how.

INFER



I can infer meaning from details stated or implied, such as characters thoughts, feelings and motives. I can justify my inferences with evidence from the text.

PREDICT




I can use what I have read to predict what might happen before, during and after reading. I can support my predictions using evidence from the text.

VOCABULARY




I can use context clues to identify the meaning of unknown words. I can replace the word with a synonym, read the whole sentence, infer meaning or look for examples in the text.

EXPLAIN



I can explain the authors use of structure and language, including figurative language, and the impact it has on the reader. I can support my answers with evidence from the text.

RETRIEVE



I can read the question carefully and skim and scan the text for keywords. The answer will always be directly in the text and can be written straight from the text.
