Lesson Objective

The student shall be able to speak and comprehend both social and business language and demonstrate effective oral communication skills.

Role Playing

Evaluation Criteria

- Ability to comprehend spoken English and speak effectively on random chosen topics

Students will be asked to participate in one of scenarios listed below. The participants will speak for approximately 5 minutes.

1. You like pets and want to bring one home. You share an apartment with a roommate and you know they do not like animals. How are you going to convince him/her to let you bring one home?
2. You have decided to move abroad and are uncertain about where to move to so you schedule a lunch with a friend to help you make your decision. In this discussion, you want to talk about things like: quality of life; employment opportunities and others.
3. Your friend recently met someone online through a matchmaking site. It seems that it worked out for them, so now you are interested so decide to meet with your friend and learn about the pros and cons of using an online dating site.
4. You are being interviewed for a job that requires strong communication skills. Talk to your prospective employer about your skills and why they make you qualified for the job.
5. You have a friend that is single but would like to adopt a child. Since you have children he/she has asked you to meet with them and talk about this life changing decision.
6. You are attending a debate about the topic “freedom of speech”. After the debate, you go out to have coffee with one of your friends that has an opposing view. Your view is that even though freedom of speech should be protected, there are limits.
7. You and two friends are going out for dinner. While in the taxi, you see a homeless person on the street so you start talking about what society should do to prevent poverty and homelessness.
8. You belong to an organization that supports welcoming of refugees. You have been asked to give a brief talk to some new employees about why there is a humanitarian responsibility to support refugees.
