## Lesson Objective

Prepare students for a variety of English tests. With consistent attendance, the student shall be able to speak and demonstrate effective oral communication skills.

**Evaluation Criteria:** Ability to comprehend spoken English and to speak effectively on random chosen images.

## Section One

### Pair Discussions

**Directive:** The teacher will choose one image from the grid below and will ask to **two** students to discuss with each other about the reasons why they think the picture was taken. They have about 2 minutes per couple. The process will repeat for the rest of the students.



## Section Two

### Decision Making

**Directive:** The teacher will ask students to imagine that a university is planning to have a debate on the subject of competition. A poster will be produced to advertise the debate. The teacher will go student by student and ask to talk about the different aspects of competition shown in the images above. In the end of their speech each student must decide which image should be used to advertise the debate. The student has about 3 minutes to talk.

### Consider these factors:

- Teams approach vs individual approach.
- The influence or impacts at a personal level and society level.
- Things we can learn from it.

**Example:** In the image K we see a school art contest. The picture was taken to show that anybody can have a talent which doesn't necessarily have to be physical. Painting helps people express things that otherwise may be difficult to express; for instance, different colors represent different emotions. It is a relaxing, harmless and therapeutic activity that can have positive effects on the individual as well as to the person watching it. Paintings can inspire societies and people can learn that not all forms of competitions are physical. It is important to have mental stimulation as well.
