

Provinces et territoires du Canada Scoot





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Scoot Instructions

This "Scoot" game is a fun way for you to:

- assess what you students already know about Canadian provinces and territories as you begin a unit on this topic.
- review key concepts and knowledge as you bring your unit on Canadian provinces and territories to an end, perhaps in preparation for a test or another type of culminating task.

Preparation:

1. Print out all materials from this resource.
2. Cut apart the individual Scoot cards. There are 30 cards, with one blank sheet to create additional cards if required (and let's hope your class is small enough that you don't need more than 30 cards)!
3. Make enough copies of the recording sheet for each student.
4. Arrange the desks so that students can move from desk to desk in a clear and safe configuration works particularly well.

Directions

1. Put a Scoot card in each desk. Each card is numbered.
2. Have students read the question, and answer sheet on their card.
3. Explain the game to students. Have them answer their next question, and ensure that they are in the correct location.
4. Once you are ready, have students move to their next location. Have them read the question and how to record their answers on the recording sheet. Give them approximately 30 seconds to answer their second question. Say "SCOOT", and have students move on to their next question. The game is over when students have returned to their own desks.
5. Take up the answers together. You may want to have students correct each other's work, depending on your particular circumstance. If you are using this as an end-of-unit review before a test, you will likely want to use this time to clear up any misconceptions about the concepts covered in the game.
