DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. In this week's teaching, you heard about a former pastor who ended up in federal prison. He claimed that he *loved* Jesus but that he did not *fear* God. How do you respond to that claim?
2. Legalism is one of the ditches we can fall into as we walk the narrow road of salvation. What examples of legalism have you witnessed during your time as a follower of Christ?
3. Lawlessness is the other ditch that we can fall into as we walk the road of salvation. What are the dangers of falling into lawlessness-both for individuals and for the church?
4. Holiness simply means being "set apart." Those who are holy are set apart exclusively for God's kingdom and belong completely to Him. In your experience, what does holiness look like in everyday life? How can you recognize that reality in others and in yourself?
5. It is important to remember that the goal of fearing God-just like the goal of holiness-is not to gain "spiritual points" but to develop a deeper intimacy with Christ. What are some ways you have experienced that intimacy, that connection, in recent months?
