

Create an HTML link that will download an Acrobat File.pdf from your Dropbox Account

- 1). Go back to your **Community.Linuxmint.com** document.
- 2). Position your cursor where you want the link to your **Acrobat File.pdf** document to appear in your document.
- 3). Use the following HTML code to create a link which will open Acrobat File.pdf in a new page

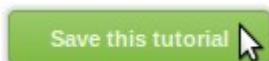
```
<a href="URL"target="_blank">Title</a>
```

- Replace **URL** with your **Modified Dropbox URL**:
- Replace **Title** with **Acrobat File.pdf**

This should gives you:

```
<a href="https://dl.dropboxusercontent.com/s/esn0p0ram575hhw/  
Acrobat%20File.png?dl=0"target="_blank">Acrobat File.pdf</a>
```

- 4). Cut and paste this **HTML** code into your tutorial.
- 5). Click on the **Save this tutorial** button at this stage:



6). You will notice that the HTML code is still visible in your tutorial.

```
<a href="https://dl.dropboxusercontent.com/s/esn0p0ram575hhw/Acrobat File.png?dl=0"target="_blank">Acrobat File.pdf</a>
```

7). Now click on the **Edit** button



followed by the **Save this tutorial** button.



8). The HTML code should no longer be visible. You should now have the following **Link** in your **Community.Linuxmint.com** tutorial:

If you **Click** on this link it should download the **Acrobat File.pdf** from your **Dropbox** account and open it up in a new webpage.
