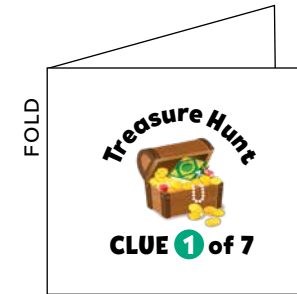

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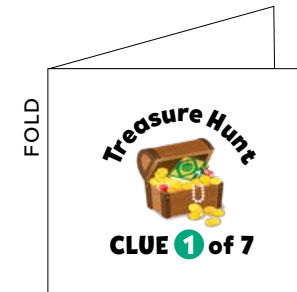
# 2 Companion Treasure Hunt

## Clue 1 of 7

Hand this clue to your child at the start of play.



Abu Hurayrah was really hungry and the Prophet ﷺ presented him with a bowl of \_\_\_\_\_. But before Abu Hurayrah could take his first sip, the Prophet ﷺ asked him to offer the \_\_\_\_\_ to all of his poor friends. Abu Hurayrah thought the \_\_\_\_\_ would be finished before he'd get a chance to drink. Finally, after everyone had drank, Abu Hurayrah had his fill from the miracle of the bowl of \_\_\_\_\_ that never ran out!

## Clue 3 of 7

Place this clue near to a **door** in house, such as on the handles of a door.

The Companion 'Uthman Ibn 'Affan was a rich man and once bought a well called Rumah and made it public property for everyone to drink \_\_\_\_\_ from it. The Prophet ﷺ said that 'Uthman would enter Paradise because of this wonderful act of kindness.

To find the next clue, look for a place where you can find \_\_\_\_\_ in your house.



## Clue 2 of 7

Place this clue near to the place where **milk** is kept in the house, such as the refridgerator.

At the time of the Prophet ﷺ, there were lots of small \_\_\_\_\_ leading from peoples houses directly in to the masjid. Just before the Prophet ﷺ passed away, he ordered that all \_\_\_\_\_ be closed, except the \_\_\_\_\_ of one Companion. That was the \_\_\_\_\_ of Abu Bakr.

To find the next clue, look near a \_\_\_\_\_ in your house.



## Clue 4 of 7

Place this clue near to a place where **water** is kept in the house, such as next to a tap.

Hafsah Bint 'Umar was the wife of the Prophet ﷺ and after he passed away, she held manuscripts of the \_\_\_\_\_. During the Khilafah of 'Uthman, Hafsah gave her manuscripts to the Khalifah, and that helped compile the copy of the \_\_\_\_\_ that we have today.

The Prophet ﷺ taught his daughter Fatimah that before going to \_\_\_\_\_, she should say "Allahu Akbar" thirty-three times, "Subhan-Allah" thirty-three times and "Al-hamdu lillah" thirty-three times.

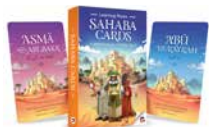
