There is a dire need for sponsors to host individuals and families in detention centers who have been admitted into the country to be considered for asylum.

Becoming a sponsor is the deepest expression of solidarity with those who have fled their home to escape violence and economic hardship. There are people in immigration detention centers who could be considered for release right now, but they do not have an individual or group willing to shelter and accompany them while they await an asylum hearing.

You can change that!

Congregational mission teams and other community groups are ideal sponsors for immigrants. It is both joyful and challenging to engage in a sponsoring relationship. The length of commitment is from 6 months to a year. Mobilizing a team to support the many aspects of sponsorship ensures that both the guests and the hosts build a strong working relationship.

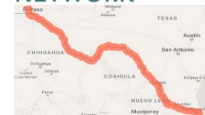
