The II Meneghello comes in large and small sizes (Grande and Piccolo). The large box is on the left and small on the right.









There's no publication date on the box but inside there's an information card that has a 1995 copyright. Doesn't have a booklet but comes with nine additional cards with meanings printed front and back.












Second Edition (2002)
