Learning to tell the time is a challenge for many children. I am sure it is something most of us remember struggling to master. The first step for all children is to have a feel for the passage of time, then later be able to tell the time and apply it to everyday life. Time is a very abstract concept and as such can present a major challenge to children with learning difficulties and disabilities. This workshop will equip participants with a structured programme of activities on how to teach the passage of time and then how, step by step, to teach a child how to tell the time. The day will finish with a look at how to introduce and develop an understanding of money; its value and uses.
