Lesson Objective

Students shall be able to demonstrate oral communication skills, both in speaking and listening comprehension, whether in a multi-student environment or while interpreting charts and graphs.

Evaluation Criteria: Students can demonstrate basic proficiency in the following four categories: Lexicon, Pronunciation, Grammar and Coherency.

Section One Timed Speaking

- Students will be asked to speak for approximately 2 minutes on selected topic. Each student will be given 1 minute after being assigned the topic to prepare.
1. What is your idea of a non-traditional family?
 2. How important is having a stable childhood to promote emotional wellbeing for a child?
 3. Will a child growing up with a single parent have a happy childhood?
 4. Can a child growing up with grandparents have a happy childhood?
 5. Can a child growing up in an adopted family have a happy childhood?
 6. What factors are most important in a child having a healthy childhood?
 7. Does living in a multi-generational family create any problems?
 8. Parents who no longer love each other should still stay together if they have young children. Yes or No? And Why?
 9. Should children be entitled to their own privacy from their parents? Yes or No? and Why?
 10. You should always be more loyal to your family, than friends, even when they have done something wrong. Yes or No? and Why?

Section Two Writing

- Students will be asked to finish three brief paragraphs, after being provided the introduction to each one by the instructor. Students will be given 5 minutes for each paragraph, with no more than 100 words being used for each one.
