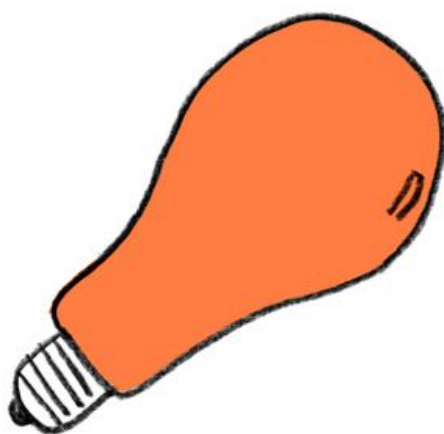

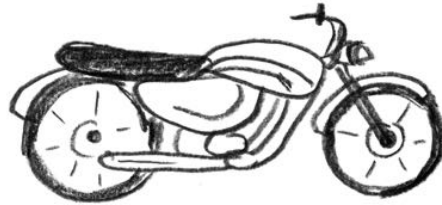

who remember

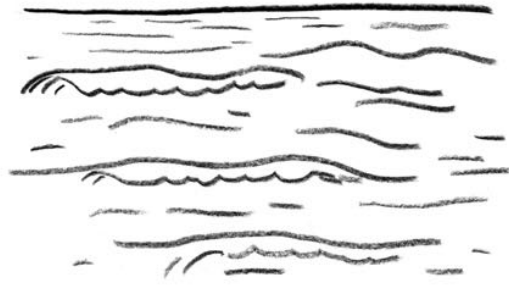
