Under the States Reorganization Act of 1956, the states were reorganized on the basis of language. Every State/UT of India has a unique demography, history, and culture, dress, festivals, language etc.

All states headed by chief minister. The two union territories, Pondicherry and the Delhi elected form government and legislatures. They are headed by a Chief Minister. Remaining union territories are directly ruled by the Central **government**. The President is the head of central government.
